### Examen of Conscience on Church, Family, and Social

Take a moment of silence. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal where self-centeredness, pride, and the need to be admired have wounded love of God and neighbor.

#### 1. Church (Parish, movements, ministries, clergy and laity)

- Have I treated the Church more as a stage for my gifts and opinions than as the Body of Christ to be loved and served?
- In my parish or ministry, do I seek status, influence, or control more than humble service and collaboration?
- Have I resented not being recognized, thanked, or consulted, letting wounded pride cool my zeal for God's work?
- Have I used Catholic language, devotions, or theology to feel superior rather than to grow in holiness and charity?
- When the Church's sins are exposed, do I react with denial and self-protection, or with repentance and intercession?
- Have I silenced, ignored, or punished those who raised honest concerns because they threatened my image or comfort?

#### 2. Family (Spouses, parents, children, siblings, extended family)

- Do I expect my family to orbit around my moods, preferences, and schedule, without a willingness to sacrifice for them?
- Have I used affection, attention, or silence as tools to control or punish family members?
- When corrected or challenged at home, do I listen, or do I react with anger, sarcasm, or withdrawal to protect my pride?
- Do I demand admiration from my spouse, parents, or children, but rarely express sincere appreciation for them?
- Have I made decisions that deeply affect my family (time, money, commitments) without truly listening to their needs?
- Do I easily see and speak about the faults of my family members, while minimizing or excusing my own?
- Have I neglected time, presence, and listening at home because I was absorbed in my own projects, screens, or comforts?
- When I hurt a family member, do I apologize promptly and concretely, or do I defend myself and wait for them to "get over it"?

#### 3. Social (Friends, work, politics, social media, culture)

- In friendships and social settings, do I genuinely ask about others and listen, or do I continually steer conversations back to myself?
- Have I chosen or dropped friends based on how they affect my image, popularity, or status?
- Do I use social media to build a false self—curated, admired, untouchable—rather than to witness to truth and charity?
- Have I mocked, shamed, or "canceled" others online or in conversation to appear virtuous, clever, or morally superior?
- Do I consume news and political debates mainly to confirm my side and attack others, instead of seeking justice and the common good?
- Have I become indifferent to the poor, the sick, the lonely, the immigrant and the marginalized because they do not benefit me or touch my world?
- In the workplace or community, have I taken credit for others' efforts, or hidden my mistakes to protect my reputation?
- Do I judge others harshly for their visible sins while excusing my own hidden pride, vanity, and self-love?

#### 4. Turning from Self to Christ

- Do I believe that my identity and worth come from being a beloved child of the Father, or from how I appear, perform, and are praised?
- Have I resisted following Christ on the path of humility, service, and hiddenness?
- Am I afraid to let go of the image I protect, even when it keeps me from deeper intimacy with God and others?

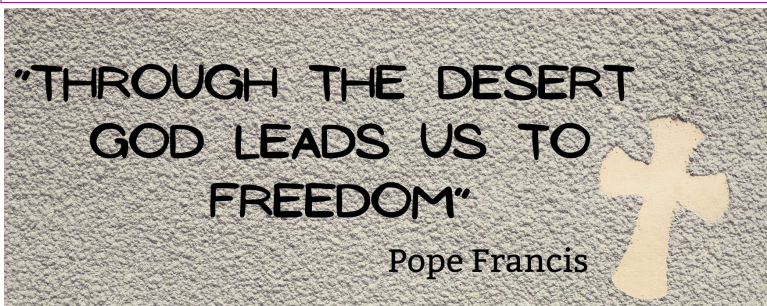
**ANOINTING OF THE SICK MASS**

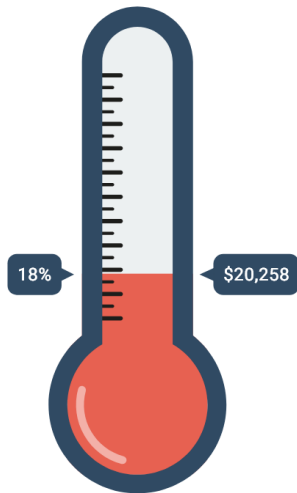

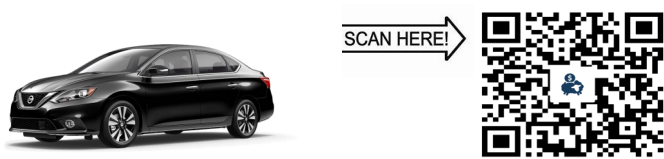
