PALM SUNDAY AND THE CROWD

On Palm Sunday the liturgy does something very striking. At the beginning of Mass, we hold blessed branches and join the crowds who welcome Jesus into Jerusalem with joy: “Hosanna to the Son of David!” We acclaim him as King and Messiah, and the mood is triumphant. Yet a short time later, as we listen to the Passion, our own voices take the part of the crowd again—this time shouting “Crucify him!” The same people who welcomed Jesus now reject him. The same city that hailed him as King hands him over to be executed.

The Church does not stage this contrast as a mere history lesson. It is a mirror. Somewhere in each of us there is a crowd that can swing from enthusiasm to rejection, from praise to betrayal, depending on whether Jesus fits the role we want him to play. When Christ blesses my plans, heals my wounds, answers my prayers as I hoped, I can easily cry “Hosanna.” But when he asks for repentance, forgiveness, sacrifice, or a change of direction—when he touches my pride and self-will—another cry can rise in my heart: “Away with him.”

In contemporary life, we have the temptation of a self-centered way of living in which everything quietly revolves around me: my feelings, my needs, my opinions, my image. Palm Sunday reveals that this temptation can reach right into our relationship with God. There is a kind of religious life style in which I still appear devout—going to Mass, saying prayers, even being involved in parish life—while secretly expecting God, the Church, and other people to orbit around my preferences. I want a Jesus who will confirm me more than a Jesus who will convert me.

We see this clearly in Passion. The leaders want to protect their influence and their status. Pilate wants to protect his position and his peace. The crowd wants a Messiah who will be impressive on their terms. Each group is locked in on its own interests, even as they stand before the One who “emptied himself” and “humbled himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross.” The Lord’s self-emptying love collides with their self-protective pride. The result is the cross.

If we are honest, we can recognize some of this in our own hearts. We may want a faith that makes us feel good but does not demand too much. We may cling to being right, being admired, being in control, even inside the Church. We may resist any teaching of Christ or of the Church that challenges our favorite sins or our comfortable compromises. We can find ourselves using religious language to defend our choices rather than allowing the Gospel to judge them.

Palm Sunday is therefore not only a doorway into Holy Week; it is a gentle but serious warning. It invites us to ask: Am I a fan of Jesus, or a disciple of Jesus? A fan welcomes the excitement of the procession; a disciple stays with him in the garden, walks with him to the cross, and surrenders to the Father’s will with him. A fan wants a Savior who “works” for me; a disciple lets Jesus be Lord, even when his will cuts across my own.

The good news is that the Lord does not expose us in order to shame us, but to heal us. He rides into Jerusalem not to punish the crowd but to save it. He enters our self-centered lives, our tangled motives, our mixed hearts, to pour out a love that is stronger than our pride. On the cross, he takes upon himself the consequences of our self-will and offers us instead the grace of his own self-emptying obedience.

As we begin Holy Week, the Lord invites us to move, step by step, from the “kingdom of me” to the true Kingdom of God. That journey will be concrete. It may mean forgiving someone we have held at a distance. It may mean making a long-delayed confession. It may mean letting go of a pattern of complaining, criticism, or control in our family. It may mean choosing a hidden act of service with no recognition. Each small act of self-forgetting love loosens the grip of narcissism and makes room for Christ.

You might take a few moments this week to pray quietly with the Passion and ask three simple questions:

- Where do my words say “Hosanna,” but my choices say, “Crucify him”?
- Where am I using my faith to protect my image, rather than to let Jesus change my heart?

What one concrete step of self-emptying love is the Lord asking of me before Easter?

If we allow him, Jesus will ride into the most self-centered corners of our hearts, not to condemn, but to transform. He knows the crowd within us; he has already carried it to the cross. May this Holy Week be a time when we let him replace our fragile “kingdom of me” with the strong, gentle reign of his mercy.

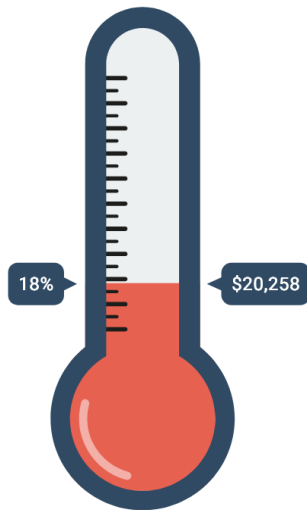


