elcome to the Boys & Girls Club of
Orchard Park! After more than a year of
disrupted learning, our Clubs continue to play a
vital role in helping youth move forward and creating
opportunities for them to thrive. When children open
our doors, they will find fun structured programs that
will keep them on track.

The Club is offering two different services this winter. First is the **Kids Club** for children in Kindergarten–5th Grade. It is a social recreation program designed for younger members. Students will be separated into pods by age groups and supervised by a trained Club Staffperson. They will spend time in each area of the Club and stay active, finish homework, create masterpieces, and more. The second option is **Junior Quakers**. As a new program for middle-school students, our goal is to make the Club a positive and fun alternative for members after school and at night. Youth will have special access to programming areas after school, and evening activities are available throughout the year.

The Boys & Girls Club of Orchard Park believes there is nothing more important than keeping children safe and protected. We will adjust our program to meet all of the current CDC, NYS and Erie County DOH guidelines. Through it all, kids have been and will remain our #1 priority.
