MESSAGE FROM DIRECTOR OF GOLF – WES BLANKENSHIP



Dear Willow Fork Members,

Welcome to April! If you know me at all, you know how much I love the game of golf and like most golf lovers, while I can eat, sleep, and breath golf all year round...April is where it's at! Why?? That's easy...Masters Week! While I know we will all be glued to coverage Thursday – Sunday, make your plans to join us for our **Green Jacket Par 3 Tournament on Tuesday, April 7th**! I've got a little something special for our Main Division & Couples Division winners this year!

Course Conditions & Updates

- The course is THIRSTY! We know it's looking dryer out there than you are used to this time of year and we could certainly use some help from Mother Nature with less than 1.25" of rain over the last 6 weeks. The pump station install was a huge upgrade for our irrigation system, but unfortunately that increase in water pressure has caused calcium build-up from our effluent water to break off and repeatedly clog heads on the golf course. We have an acid injection system ordered and scheduled to be installed Thursday, April 9th that will break down the calcium and allow our irrigation lines and heads to get back to work. More details to come from Willy and our agronomy team very soon.

Pro Tip: Master the Chip-and-Run

I see too many amateurs using high-lofted wedges around the green when a simple bump-and-run will do, especially in these dryer conditions.

1. **Setup:** Feet close together, body open slightly to the hole, weight on the lead foot.
2. **Club Selection:** Use a 48 or PW, you can also utilize an 8 or 9 iron.
3. **Stroke:** Use a putting stroke motion. Let the ball roll!
