MESSAGE FROM DIRECTOR OF GOLF – WES BLANKENSHIP



Dear Willow Fork Members,

Heading into September, we could all use a little help from Mother Nature with some much-needed rain and a break from the heat. **We are especially excited for installation of our new irrigation system to begin. We anticipate that all parts will be delivered sometime during the first two weeks of September and installation will begin shortly after on holes 4, 5, & 6 with a 90 day completion goal.** More details to come as we are able to finalize the timeline. Please see below for a portion of the email that was sent out on July 24th with more detail about how the project will proceed and what kind of impact to expect on the golf course.

This upgrade will be a game changer for the golf course. While conditions are currently dry, our greens remain healthy thanks to our maintenance team's diligent hand-watering efforts and continued work to clear clogs and perform repairs to the aging hydraulic system. The new two-wire system will allow us to irrigate areas we could not consistently reach before, while freeing our team from constantly chasing issues around the property.

In the meantime, we need your help protecting the golf course. Turf under heat and drought stress is more easily damaged, and a few small adjustments can make a meaningful difference:

- **Practice Smart Cart Driving:** Please observe the 90-degree rule and keep carts on the paths as much as possible. Cross fairways directly and park with all four tires on the path near greens and tees.
- **Fill Divots and Repair Ball Marks:** Dry turf takes longer to recover. Please use the provided sand to fill your divots and carefully repair ball marks on the greens.

September also brings one of our favorite times of the year...Club Championship season! The SGA hosts their Championship on September 8 & 9, with the Women's and Junior Club Championships held on September 12, followed by the Men's Club Championship on September 19 & 20. We look forward to an exciting month of competition and hope you will join us in supporting the players.

TWO-WIRE ELECTRIC IRRIGATION PROJECT INFORMATION

Thanks to the outstanding partnership between Juniper Golf Properties, Encore Leisure Group and Professional Turf Products (PTP), we've been able to move this project forward on an accelerated timeline. We're incredibly grateful for their support in helping bring this investment to Willow Fork. We're equally excited to partner with Legacy Course Solutions, a company that has ties to numerous irrigation projects throughout the Encore portfolio. Legacy is already familiar with Willow Fork, having recently helped identify and eliminate the massive calcium blockage deep within our irrigation system at holes 4, 5, & 6. Their experience and knowledge of our property make them the perfect partner to lead this installation.

When complete, the new system will include:

- 749 new electric irrigation heads
- New swing joints at every head
- Two central communication HUBs replacing our outdated hydraulic controllers
- More than 120,000 linear feet (22+ miles) of communication wire

Rather than digging massive trenches across the property, Legacy Course Solutions will utilize a vibratory plow, which allows communication wire to be installed beneath the turf with minimal disruption. This equipment significantly reduces installation time while preserving established turf. While some traditional trenching may be necessary in selected locations, the vast majority of the project will be completed using this process.

This project also creates an opportunity we've never had before. As each hole is converted, Legacy and our maintenance team will perform a complete "super flush" of that section of irrigation pipe. The acid injection system has already done an incredible job dissolving years of calcium buildup, and this process will remove as much of the remaining material as possible before each hole is placed into service on the new system.

One of the most exciting aspects of the installation is that as each hole is finished, it will immediately transition to the new two-wire system while the remaining holes continue operating on the existing hydraulic system. For much of the project, we'll essentially be running two irrigation systems simultaneously, allowing us to improve the golf course one hole at a time.

Most materials have already been delivered with the expectation that remaining and final deliveries will be made by the second week of September. PTP and Legacy are working together along with our team here at the club to make sure all parties are ready to begin installation at the first opportunity. **Installation is expected to take approximately 90 days, weather permitting.**

We recognize that places us into **late fall or early December for completion**, but our expectation is that golfers will experience very little disruption. Installation will occur one hole at a time, and **we will provide regular updates throughout the project while coordinating closely with Legacy to ensure tournaments and association events proceed as scheduled and uninterrupted.**

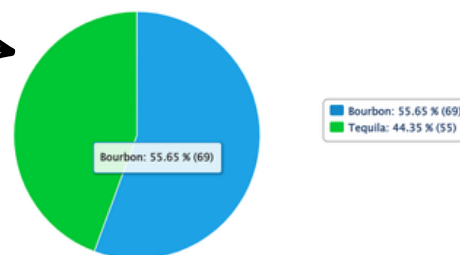
