# Schedule a meeting with your legislators

It's time to take action to pass PBM reform. We need to bring every Kansas legislator into a local pharmacy to meet with a pharmacy champion (you!) and learn about PBM reform before the end of the year, before the hectic legislative session starts in January. One-on-one meetings give legislators insight into pharmacy, introduce them to PBM reform, and establish you as a local expert they can rely on for information. **Questions, comments, or need help? ### ☐ Email your legislators to schedule your meetings (10 min)

- ☐ [Find your legislators](#) through your work or home address (or that you have a relationship with them).
- ☐ Find their email address on the [KS State Legislators website](#)
- ☐ Email their home and work email addresses using the [sample email template](#) (PDF)
- ☐ Follow up if needed: Call their office if no response after 2-3 business days using the sample phone call template
- ☐ Tips
  - **Schedule your meeting to be held before the end of the year.**
  - You may schedule up to 3 legislators in one meeting, but typically not more. Individual, personal conversations are most effective.
  - Never schedule a Democrat and Republican at the same meeting
  - You should invite a few other pharmacists, technicians, students, and patients to attend in support. Groups of advocates can be very powerful.
