^{*} What is a clearinghouse? A clearinghouse/medical intermediary is an organization that enables the exchange of data between the provider and the payer. It is a HIPAA covered entity that can translate between standard and non-standard transaction formats. As such, clearinghouses/medical intermediaries enable data submission from provider systems into the HIPAA 837 claim format required for claims submission and payment.

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^{**} Providers who chose to submit direct entry claims on the KMAP secured portal must register to access the KMAP secured portal. Registration guides can be found on the Login page by scrolling to the bottom on the page and select Provider.

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If Provider uses the KMAP secure portal for uploading batch claims or will be submitting claims to KMAP using a third party vendor, an EDI <u>Electronic Claims Submission Application</u> is required – if you are already using KMAP for DME billing, you do not need to fill out a new application.
