

Pediatric Associates PSC Vaccine Information

Thank you for choosing Pediatric Associates, PSC as your child's healthcare provider. In order to keep your child as healthy as possible, we recommend a childhood vaccination schedule consistent with the American Academy of Pediatrics guidelines. The following chart lists the schedule in our office for these childhood vaccines.

Birth	Hep B #1. **Note – While not a vaccination, Ped Associates also recommends newborns receive a Vitamin K injection for prevention of hemorrhagic disease of the newborn (HDN)
2 mo	DTaP/IPV/HIB#1, PCV 20 #1, HEP B#2, Rotavirus#1
4 mo	DTaP/IPV/HIB#2, PCV 20 #2, Rotavirus #2
6 mo	DTaP/IPV/HIB#3, PCV 20 #3, Rotavirus #3
9 mo	HepB #3
12 mo	MMR #1, Varicella #1 , HEP A #1
15 mo	DTaP /IPV/HIB#4, PCV 20 #4
18 mo	Hep A #2 MCHAT
2 yr	Hep A #2 (if not completed at 18mo wcc)
	2 ½ and 3 year old well visits do not have required vaccines; annual flu vaccine is recommended
4 yr	DTaP/IPV (Quadracel), MMRV (Proquad)
	5-9 year old annual well visits do not have additional required vaccines; annual flu vaccine is recommended
10 yr	Tdap #1. Meningitis ACWY #1 (given prior to or just after 11 th birthday)
11 yr	Tdap #1, Meningitis ACWY #1 if not given at 10 year old WCC
11+	Human Papilloma Virus (Gardasil 9) series
16 yr	Meningitis ACWY #2 (must be 16 yrs)
	17-20 year old well visits do not have required vaccines; Meningitis B vaccine (Bexsero) is offered; annual flu vaccine is recommended
	Infant/Toddler series with brand names RSV monoclonal antibody (Beyfortus)– Recommended but not required; given to infants under 8 months of age during RSV season (10/1-3/31) if mother did not receive RSV vaccine during current pregnancy Dtap/IPV/HIB= Diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis, polio, and hemophilus influenza (Pentacel combination vaccine) Hep B – Hepatitis B (Recombivax HB) PCV 20 – Pneumococcal 20 serotype vaccine (Prevnar 20) Rotavirus oral vaccine – (Rotateq) Hep A – Hepatitis A (Vaqta) MMR – Measles, Mumps and Rubella combination vaccine Varicella – Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine
	4 year old vaccines with brand names: DTaP/IPV (Diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis and polio) (Quadracel) MMR/V (measles, mumps, rubella and varicella) (Proquad)
	11 year old vaccines are one combination and one single antigen vaccine: Tdap – Tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (Adacel) and Meningitis ACWY (Menquadfi)
	Also recommended seasonal vaccines: Beyfortus monoclonal antibody during RSV season (October 1-March 31) to infants under 8 months if mom did not receive RSV vaccine during pregnancy; Annual flu vaccine starting at age 6 months (Flucelvax) (2 doses first season); COVID-19 vaccine (2025 -AAP recommends for all ages 6m-2y; older ages per health risk or family and provider discussion)
