## **June 1, 2025**

It is interesting that as I went through my photos from the sabbatical, I found only this representation of the Ascension. It is contained in a series of frescoes painted in the mid-16th century above the 5th century mosaics of the Old Testament, depicting Mary's role in Salvation History (here she is front and center at the Ascension to receive the vocation to go and preach to all nations with the reassurance that Christ will be with them).

There are many images of the Transfiguration and Resurrection, and even more of the Assumption of Mary, but almost none of the Ascension. Is it perhaps that the Ascension marks the transition from the world with Jesus physically present to the world where he is spiritually present in those who have faith in him: the Church. This must have been a hard transition for the disciples, and I believe it is a difficult transition for us today. Like the disciples, we are challenged to "see" Christ in ourselves and one another. We are challenged to go out into the world to be the "Good News" for all people. We are much more comfortable with the tangible, whereas he is present to us in intangible ways, which we can only perceive when we trust in his love for us and for all. It was a pivotal moment in the early Church. It is a pivotal moment in the Church of our day.
