

Music is a very important, integral part of the funeral liturgy. It is recommended that the congregation have a role in the liturgy by being allowed an opportunity to sing. As a practice only current members of the music program at St. Thomas can lead music for funeral Masses because they are familiar with our practices, our sound system, and can best lead the peoples' parts of the Mass (Holy, Holy, Memorial Acclamation, Great Amen, etc.). We have several keyboardists, organists and vocalists available. If you have someone in particular in mind, please make your request known.
