- Call us for help!



The Better Birth Outcomes-Comprehensive program is designed to help birthing persons and infants up to 6 months of age.

Risk factors which may qualify you for the program include:

- Diseases that affect pregnancy or infants
- Homelessness/ in temporary housing
- Teen or over 45 years old
- Pregnant with multiples
- Previous pre-term delivery or low birth weight
- Mental health issues
- Previously incarcerated or under house arrest
- DCFS involvement in the past year
- Victim of domestic violence
- Alcohol, tobacco, or other substance abuse during pregnancy
- Complex medical issues
- Many other risk factors





If you qualify for this program, you may receive:

- Personalized prenatal and postpartum education.
- Community referrals and linkage to services provided free of charge.
