NEEDED VACCINES:

- DTaP (5th dose)
- Polio (4th dose)
- MMR (2nd dose)
- Varicella (chickenpox 2nd dose)
- Hepatitis A (if not received prior)

NEEDED VACCINES:

- Tdap
- Meningitis (Men ACWY)
- Hepatitis A (if not received prior)

NEEDED VACCINES:

- Meningitis (Men ACWY 2nd dose)
- Meningitis B (Bexsero or Trumenba)
- Hepatitis A (if not received prior)

At age 16 and older, your child is eligible to receive their 2nd dose of Meningitis (ACWY) and begin their Meningitis B vaccine 2 dose series.

Meningitis B disease makes up most of the cases of Meningitis disease. MenB is a potentially deadly disease that progresses quickly and leads to death in 24 hours. Teens and young adults ages 16-23 are at higher risk.
