Job Title: Healthworks Lead Agency Case Manager Coordinator

Job Type: Full-Time

Company Overview: The Macon County Health Department is a Certified Local Health Department that

provides clinical and social preventive services for all ages through the operation of various programs, services, and partnerships. Our vision is to lead Macon County to be one of the healthiest counties in Illinois and our mission is to promote the health

and healthy practices of all residents of Macon County.

Summary: Develops and maintains a healthcare delivery system for children in the legal care

and custody of the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) in the designated eight (8) county areas: Clark, Cumberland, Coles, Edgar, Douglas, Macon, Moultrie, and Shelby. Job responsibilities may include but are not limited to: Develops a network of qualified providers capable of delivering defined healthcare to youth in care. Performs assessments, service plans, referrals, and reassessment of participants needs. Provides evaluation, supervision, oversight, and support to HWIL Case Manager and HWIL Case Manager Assistant. Maintains working relationships with primary care providers and updates providers on changes and requirements. Serves as focal point for initial referrals to network providers and specialty healthcare

provider referrals by network participants, caretakers, and medical case

management agencies. Provides DCFS youth in care and their caregivers with an adequate network of Primary Care Providers and Handbook which describes all aspects of the network including provider names, site addresses, telephone numbers, and services offered. Improves Healthworks Program by providing inservice training and updates to network providers, caregivers, Healthworks Medical Case Manager, and DCFS staff. Provides interim medical case management services to all new youth in DCFS care. Document all information in Statewide Automated Child Welfare Information System (SACWIS) and distribute Accredited Case Review (ACR) packets. Attends workshops, conference trainings, conference

calls, and completes program audits pertaining to the Healthworks program.

Minimum Qualifications: A registered professional nurse or a licensed clinical social worker.
