Dear parishioners,

Of all the crises we can name in the Church today, perhaps the deepest is an identity crisis—we have forgotten who we are and what we are called to do as a Church. If we exist for mission, then what is that mission? Jesus gave us four clear tasks: "Go, make disciples, baptize them, and teach them all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19-20). The task of making disciples is at the very heart of our mission.

A disciple of Jesus is "engaged in a lifelong process of learning from and about Jesus." Our goal is not simply to make believers or "practicing Catholics," but true disciples. As Fr. James Mallon writes in <u>Divine Renovation</u>:

"To receive this Good News, to be evangelized, is not only to hear these wonderful truths, to know about them, but to come to know Him—to not just believe in Him but love Him and be in love with Him."

We must work intentionally to create spaces where people can encounter Jesus as the living Lord, awaken a hunger for Him, and begin a journey of discipleship. We must rediscover our identity and place the Lord's mandate for His Church at the center of everything we do. When we do this, at the heart of every parish will be a community of growing, maturing believers—committed to lifelong learning, discovering their gifts, prepared to serve, and ready to become apostles (those who are sent).

It is in this spirit that I personally invite you to take part in a formation process inspired by Divine Renovation, founded by Fr. James Mallon and supported by the Archdiocese of Chicago.



The same sessions will be offered on Wednesdays, October 8, 15, and 22.
