THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BURK'S FALLS

BY-LAW 22-2008

Being a By-law to regulate the disposal of refuse or debris Within the Village of Burk's Falls and repeal By-law 16-2007

WHEREAS Section 127 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, permits municipalities to pass by-laws prohibiting the throwing, placing, or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality; and

WHEREAS it is desirable to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris in any place in the Township of Armour, Ryerson, Burk's Falls landfill site.

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Village of Burk's Falls enacts as follows:

- 1. In this by-law, refuse and debris shall have the meanings normally ascribed to them and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall include:
 - 1.1 The portions and containers of food unused or discarded in the preparation, service and consuming thereof.
 - 1.2 All discarded material arising or resulting from the operation of households, business establishments and public places; and
 - 1.3 Brush, stones, surplus concrete or asphalt, broken concrete or asphalt, tires, appliances, furniture, clothing, material from construction or demolition projects, vehicles or equipment.

2. GENERAL DUTIES AND OBLICATIONS TO COMPLY:

- 2.1 No person shall spill, scatter, deposit, throw, cast, lay or cause to be thrown any refuse or debris on any street, lane, alley, laneway, roadway, road allowance, public or private way, or in any public square, place or private lot.
- 2.2 Materials applied to land for agricultural purposes are exempt from the provision of this by-law.

3. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 3.1 The Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officer appointed by the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls shall enforce this by-law.
- 3.2 Any person who contravenes any of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty of \$ 5,000.00 (five thousand dollars) for each offence exclusive of the costs, as prescribed by the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. cP.33, as amended.
- 3.3 This by-law shall come into force upon receiving its short form wording and will thereupon repeal the former Village of Burk's Falls By-Law # 16-2007.
- 3.4 This by-law shall be referred to as the Dumping By-law.
