6h	Motion – NOTICE OF MOTION Proposers: Cllr Karl Johnson & Cllr Brian James Background: Following Rhondda Cynon Taf Council's implementation of reduced Home to School Transport provision, hundreds of children across our community are now forced to use local bus services to travel to their education settings.	

	These changes affect secondary school pupils travelling to: • Garth Olwg in Church Village • Bryncelynnog in Beddau • Ysgol Gyfun Garth Olwg in Hawthorn • Cardinal Newman RC in Rhydyfelin • College students at Coleg y Cymoedd in Nantgarw In recent weeks, large numbers of students have been observed waiting at bus stops in poor weather conditions without adequate shelter. Whilst Llantwit Fardre Community Council owns and maintains a number of bus shelters, there remain key locations across our area of responsibility where no such provision exists. Motion: This Council calls upon Llantwit Fardre Community Council to: 1. Write to Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council to express concern regarding the impact of the reduced Home to School Transport provision on local students 2. Seek the appropriate permissions and any available financial assistance to install three new bus shelters at locations currently without such provision: a) Garth Olwg School – Main Road (both directions) b) Llest Terrace, Llantwit Fardre (Tonteg-bound) Funding Proposal: it is further proposed that the cost of these infrastructure improvements could be met through Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) receipts and/or existing budget allocations. Recommendation: That Council supports this motion to improve safety, comfort and wellbeing for students and the wider community.
