REPORT OF THE CLERK AND EXECUTIVE OFFICER

1. REPAIRS TO VANDALISED BUS SHELTERS

- 1.1 As Members are aware, several new bus shelters have been installed throughout various locations within the Community Council's area, all of which have been donated by the Unitary Authority. Unfortunately, two bus shelters have recently been vandalised and now require urgent attention.
- 1.2 The damage to the bus shelters and their respective locations are shown below:-
 - Heol Salem, Church Village – the back glass panel has been smashed.
 - Meadow Farm (Bellway), Llantwit Fardre – the two polycarbonic panels have been completely damaged, both the back panel plate and the noticeboard have been removed (copy of photo attached).
- 1.3 The Clerk contacted the Unitary Authority to ascertain who would be able to carry out the repair works to the bus shelters and was given the contact details for Groundwork Services.
- 1.4 To supply and fit polycarbonate to replace the glass panel to the bus shelter located at Heol Salem, Church Village would cost £148.00 and to complete the necessary works to the bus shelter at Meadow Farm (Bellway), Llantwit Fardre would cost £298.00 (this does not include the cost of a replacement noticeboard).
- 1.5 The Police have been informed of the two separate incidents of vandalism and the young offender who smashed the glass at Heol Salem, Church Village has been questioned by the Police, unfortunately, there were no witnesses to the incident that took place at Meadow Farm.

2. RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 Members are requested to approve the repairs to be carried out at both bus shelters in the total sum of £446.00 as quoted by Groundwork Services.
