REPORT OF THE CLERK

1. CHRISTMAS FUNDAY 2025 UPDATE

1.1 The Annual Christmas Funday is held to celebrate the festive season with the community and to encourage local engagement and support local community groups across the four wards. This event will take place on the 6th December 2025 10.00am to 4.00pm (set up will commence from 7.00am).

1.2 The table below provides Members with an event and financial summary which was agreed at the meeting of Leisure and Amenities Committee held on the 10th March 2025.

1.3 To date the sum of **£4,324.77** has been spent on the deposit for the event package, other payments will be made nearer to the time. Estimated total cost **£11,000**

1.4 The event will follow the same structure as in previous years:

- i. The **ice rink** will be located in the main hall of the Llantwit Fardre Leisure Centre, along with additional stalls and games.
- ii. **GTFM** will provide music and entertainment throughout the day.

- iii. The **snow globe, rodeo reindeer, and fairground attractions** will be set up outside the Llantwit Fardre Sports and Community club outside area.
- iv. The **fairground rides** and **food truck** will be in the car park area.
- v. Inside the Llantwit Fardre Sports and Community Club, there will be **craft stalls** and **Santa's Grotto**.
- vi. **First Aid cover** has been arranged.
- vii. **Selection boxes** will need to be purchased as in previous years.

2. **VOLUNTEERS**

The Clerk seeks permission from Members to recruit volunteers in line with the **Volunteer Policy** previously agreed by Council.
