73. PLAY AREA AT PARC NANT CELYN, EFAIL ISAF

With reference to Minute No.67 of the Council Meeting held on the 25th July, 2022, the Clerk informed Members of discussions that had taken place between the Parks & Play Strategy Manager of RCTCBC and herself following the receipt of the Safeguarding Report and the Parks Inspectorate Report and the areas

of concern that were raised within the said reports that could be mitigated were looked into.

At the meeting, the Clerk reported that the pieces of equipment that were deemed unsafe had been removed by the Council's Operatives and foliage had been severely cut back and the vegetation surrounding some of the trees to give a better and clearer line of sight had also been cut back by Rangers employed by RCTCBC.

Following a discussion, it was **RESOLVED –**

1. that the play area at Parc Nant Celyn, Efail Isaf be re-opened on Monday, 15th August, 2022 subject to all the necessary works being completed to a satisfactory standard i.e. repairs to the safety surface within the park;
2. that RCTCBC be notified accordingly.
3. to note that a Safeguarding Policy is to be presented to the Council Meeting scheduled to take place on the 26th September, 2022 for adoption and will include the designation of a Welfare Officer.
