URGENT ITEMS – REPORTS OF THE CLERK

1. MOTIONS

- (a) Members are requested to note that the Motion standing in the names of Community Councillors G.Warren (Propser) and A.Green (Seconder) as shown at Agenda Item 8(a) has been withdrawn.
- (b) The Motion standing in the names of Community Councillors K.Johnson (Proposer) and B.James (Seconder) as shown at Agenda Item 8(b) is now to be considered in the names of K.Johnson (Proposer) and J.James (Seconder).

2. FINANCIAL SUPPORT - MORGAN SINDALL

- 2.1 At the meeting of the Leisure and Amenities Committee held on the 23rd October, 2023, Members gave consideration to the support offered by Morgan Sindall either financially or carrying out some works.
- 2.2 As reported at the meeting held on the 23rd October, 2023, the Clerk responded with an initial `wish list` such as the repair works to the surfacing/access to the play areas at Heol y Parc, Tonteg, Ysgol Ty Coch and Woodlands Lower and the supply of goal posts for installation at Station Road, Church Village.
- 2.3 A further suggestion was made by a Member that the BMX ramps be placed on an area of land at Ysgol Ty Coch, however, it was indicated at the meeting that a consultation with the local residents would need to be undertaken.
- 2.4 It was further suggested by the Clerk that a contribution be made to the purchase of new gym equipment at Tonteg Park as the parts that were missing from one of the units could no longer be sourced.

2.5 Following the meeting of the Leisure and Amenities Committee, the Clerk emailed the Head of 21st Century Schools of RCTCBC and Morgan Sindall to seek clarification on how much of a contribution could the Council expect. In response, the Clerk was informed that they could not provide this Council with a budget but if the Council could provide costs of a few different options, then they would be considered.

2.6 Members are requested to give further suggestions in order that an appropriate list of proposals together with costs can be presented to Morgan Sindall via the Head of 21st Century Schools, RCTCBC.
