From the Pastor's Desk

As we approach the outermost end of the Christmas season on February 2 (Feast of the Presentation of the Lord) I would like to offer my most heartfelt thanks to all the parishioners who so generously gave me Christmas gifts! That is unnecessary but greatly appreciated. It is my strict policy, instilled by my late mother, to write thank you notes for every gift I receive before using them. Hopefully you received one of these from me. But I know it is also possible I may have forgotten to write one or two in the mix. For that reason I want to make sure you know of my gratitude. If you didn't get a handwritten thank you note from me, please know that is an oversight and accept my sincere apologies. My mom would require nothing less. Whether it was gifts of bourbon, cash, gift cards, or something more unique I truly appreciate your generosity, not because of the material gifts themselves but because of the love that motivated their giving. I do not take that support for granted and I thank you for helping to make this Christmas an especially happy one for me. May God reward you for your kindness to His unworthy priest!

Changing gears a bit I'd love to offer some information that I hope will be helpful. I offer it because recently I have received several questions from parishioners that, sadly, I was unable to answer right there on the spot. As much as I would like to know everything and be able to answer any question this is simply not possible for my limited human nature. So, the advice I give is this: If you have questions about the finances of the parish, offering envelopes, tax return letters, Mass stipends, etc. those should be directed to Kelli or Karen. I do not personally keep the books of the parish as I am most unqualified to do so. I don't even file my own income taxes! When I have a question about parish finances I myself ask Kelli or Karen because they know infinitely more about it than I do. So, I encourage you to do the same thing as me and direct business questions to the business manager and her assistant.

Similarly, if you have a question or concern about the school, I appreciate that and would like you to be able to receive a satisfactory answer as soon as possible. However, I do not personally run the school nor set its policies as that work is entrusted to our principal Mr. Travis Heckber who is more qualified than I in the field of education. When I have a question about the school, I direct it to Travis because he knows more about it than I do. So, I encourage you to do the same thing as me. All questions and concerns are welcome when they are voiced respectfully (and they usually are). I just feel bad when people come to me with questions I cannot answer and can see the disappointment on their faces when I direct them to the person who can actually help. Please know that we are transparent, there are no secrets, and we want you to be able to receive the information you are requesting as soon as possible. But please help me to help you by first going to the people whose job it is to oversee the specific areas you have a question about. Our parish is blessed to have trustworthy, helpful, and competent employees like Kelli, Karen, and Travis and they are happy to be utilized. Needless to say, while they handle the practical realities of parish life I remain available to answer questions that are of a theological, philosophical, moral, liturgical, or pastoral nature. That's what my training is in, and I am happy to give answers to the types of questions I have been prepared to answer. I hope that makes sense and is received in the same spirit with which it is offered. I'm not trying to push folks away. It's simply an admission that I don't know all the details but fortunately there are people who do and they would love to help you out just like they help me.

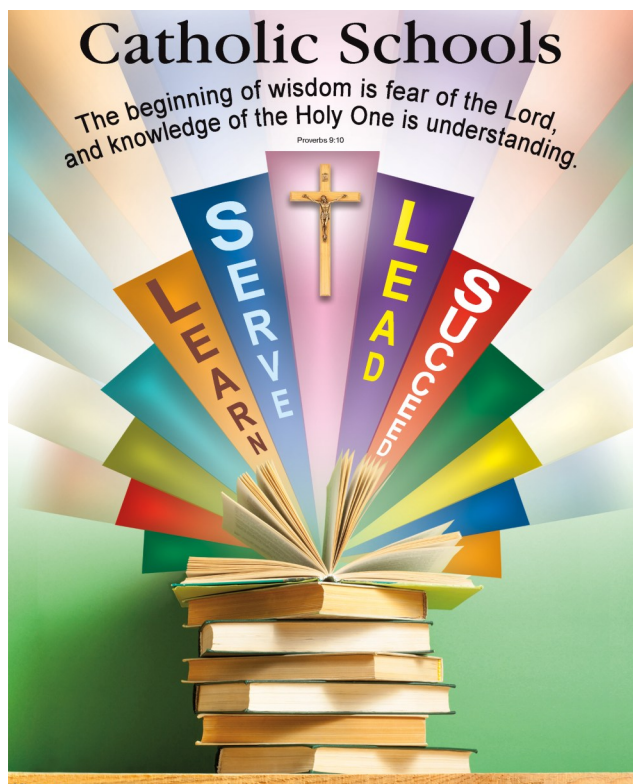
