#### From the Pastor's Desk

I'd like to thank the St. Rose Church family for praying for and financially supporting the school, which is by far our parish's largest and most active ministry of outreach/ evangelization. Even though the air-conditioner is not yet fixed our school year is off to a great start. When I was a child, we never went back to school until after Labor Day, so in my mind it is still summer break. Our diocese is very generous to provide its priests annually with four weeks of vacation and one week for retreat. I'd like to imagine I work hard enough to deserve these vacation days, but even if I don't, I still believe in using them all since they don't roll over into the next year if they are unused! That being the case this week I will be traveling to north central Pennsylvania to attend the Hammond family reunion (my late mother's people). We haven't had a family reunion in 15 years! Since the location of the reunion is guite near where one of my classmates is assigned, I will also spend a few days camping with my good buddy Fr. Josh Cavender of the Diocese of Harrisburg (Bishop Rhoades' home diocese). After that I will return to my alma mater Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg, Maryland. There I will visit our diocese's 5 transitional deacons who will (God-willing) be ordained priests for us on June 6, 2026. They are the last class of men our diocese has at Mount St. Mary's as all the younger seminarians now attend St. Meinrad in southern Indiana. This will be a bittersweet trip for me as it is likely the last time I will visit the campus where I spent 9 years of my life both as an undergraduate and a seminarian preparing to be the best priest I can for you.

More important than any of that, on Tuesday, September 9th, our parish catechism class for adults will resume. These classes will also serve as what had been called RCIA, the informational sessions for those who might be interested in joining the Catholic Church at Easter. If you know anybody who has questions about what the Church teaches and would like to find out more please have them e-mail me at EasternRoman@gmail.com.

Also, if you know somebody who does not already have a church to attend (or even if they do!) they are most welcome to come and find out more about Catholicism. There is never any pressure to convert. Last but not least, cradle Catholics are also welcome to this class and in recent years have even formed the majority. As you are well aware, the last time most Catholics received any kind of formal religious teaching was in the 8th grade before Confirmation. There is a lot more to learn about our Faith, especially now that we can comprehend things on an adult level.

So I encourage ALL St. Rose parishioners to mamake learning about God a priority and attend any of these classes you can. As in past years our textbook will be the Baltimore Catechism supplemented by the beautiful videos of the Catholicism Series produced by Bishop Robert Barron. Classes will meet every Tuesday (with some exceptions) in the parish hall immediately after the 6:00 P.M. Mass. As in past years we will likely have dinner provided at the beginning of class. Everything should be concluded by 8:00 or 8:30 at the latest.
