## **TUESDAY, MARCH 31<sup>st</sup> - 7:00 pm**

Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception

The Holy Chrism is consecrated, and the oil of catechumens and oil of the sick are blessed by the Bishop. This beautiful Mass manifests the communion of the priests with their bishop in the same priesthood and ministry of Christ. All are encouraged to attend.

## **HOLY TRIDUUM: THREE HOLIEST DAYS**

The Triduum is the highest point of the entire liturgical year. It is a three-part liturgy that extends over three days and celebrates and makes present the paschal mystery of Christ: his passion, death and resurrection. It begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday.
