### Proposed allocation of funding 2024.2025 sports, PE and promoting healthy lifestyles

The Sports Funding was allocated (will be spent) against:

- A swimming coach in order to match coaching more precisely to the swimming ability.
- Swimming provision for children in EYFS and Key Stage 1
- Resources to support sport and PE during lunchtimes and playtimes
- Additional adults to promote activity at lunchtimes
- Transport and additional staff so children can take part in competitive events and festivals, engaging with other young people in the area
- A sports week including inspirational visitors and trips to develop physical activity
- Trips to inspirational sporting events
- External experienced PE Teachers to improve quality of regular PE provision
- Membership for cluster sports events

### Objectives

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
- the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport

### Monitoring

The PE/Sports Subject Leader will oversee this in partnership with the Head Teacher who will look at the impact and progress sports funding has had on pupil progress and involvement.

### Swimming (Summer 2025)

100% of Year 6 children are able to

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situation
