This week we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday and next Sunday, however, are designated as solemnities, special days that call attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today, on the first Sunday after Pentecost, celebrate Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity—one God three persons.

the assurances to he must leave the future because of the help will send them the Holv Spirit. In this section he focuses more on the shape of the future. which will include Jesus' victory over the world that they will share in. The disciples of Jesus cannot know the future. They can only know that. whatever shape the future takes, they will not have to face it alone. They have the Spirit of Truth, who will continue the teaching provide of Jesus in the future.

Reading this passage Trinity Sunday reinforces our understanding of the unity shared by the members of the Trinity. Although

the idea of one God in three persons remains a mystery, we have the assurance that, as Jesus and the Father share all, Jesus and the Spirit share all.



GETTING TO KNOW THE TRINITY

As if his own life, his teachings about God's love, his miracles, his death and resurrection were not enough, Jesus told us something about God that we never would have imagined: There are three Persons in one God. It is also something we cannot completely comprehend. So instead of trying to explain it, let's look at what it means for us believers.

One thing it shows is that God wants to be known by us. In ancient times, people would expect their gods to be mysterious and hidden. God sees us not as a threat, but as beloved children. God wants to be known by those whom God loves.

The Trinity also shows us that "God is love" because the three Persons are united in one God. God calls us to be united in love with God and with each other. Remember that God knows us perfectly and still loves us. Yet knowing our weaknesses and our sins does not hurt God's love for us. On the contrary, our weaknesses allow God to help us by forgiving sins, or inspiring someone to come to our assistance. We may not be able to grasp the full meaning of the Holy Trinity, but knowing that God shares this with faithful people helps us to love God even more.


