

The narrator says Jesus tells a parable, but it is really wise advice to both guests and hosts

move if someone more important arrives. This is more than just a lesson about dinner etiquette. It is advice on how to find your true place in the Kingdom of God. Jesus advises hosts not to invite people who would be expected to repay them dinner but invite those who could not repay: the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. This is where real blessings can be found.

In these sayings, Luke gives us not advice on how approach the end times but also on how to live according to Jesus' vision of

society. Luke's Gospel also advises us how the Church must be part of bringing about this society. It is yet another example in Luke's Gospel of the reversal the kingdom brings about.

# CONDITIONAL BAPTISM WHAT IT IS AND WHEN IT IS APPLIED? A THEOLOGICAL AND PASTORAL GUIDE

#### 1. What Is Conditional Baptism?

Conditional baptism is a sacrament administered when there is reasonable doubt about the validity of a previous baptism. Unlike ordinary baptism, which is performed with certainty that it is being administered for the first time, conditional baptism is conferred with the formula: "If you are not baptized, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

#### Why is it necessary?

Baptism imparts an **indelible mark on the soul** (cf. Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1272), meaning it cannot be repeated. However, if there is uncertainty about whether a prior baptism was valid (e.g., if the Trinitarian formula was not used or if there was no intention to do what the Church does), the Church permits this act under condition to ensure the salvation of the soul without committing sacrilege.


