What's important to you?

When I served as interim minister in Andover, Iowa, the Southeastern Iowa Synod created a deck of cards with discussion questions on them to help churches reflect on their ministry. Every once in a while, I will pull out the deck and go through them for inspiration. Recently, one stood out to me. It asks, “what is the single most important thing that being part of a congregation has contributed to your life?”

I knew right away what my answer would be, community! My home church, Kingo Lutheran had it in spades. In fact, it is Christian community that has inspired my path into ordained ministry. I have seen the love of God reflected in the hearts and souls of those who have cared for me in my times of need, so I am inspired to do the same for others. That's why fellowship is so important to me! It was over coffee and cake that I found a place I belonged and offered help when I felt helpless. I knew the message of God's love to be true when folks I hardly knew would say, “can I get you another cup of coffee?” or, “how was your week?” This love pushed me to ministry.

A slight shift. For years now, St. Paul and Immanuel have done an annual stewardship drive in the fall. You know the drill, you get the letter in the mail and maybe a Temple Talk or two. This year we are going to do it differently, and you'll learn more after the Annual Meeting. But ahead of that, I want to pose the question to you to begin pondering,

What is the single most important thing that being part of this congregation has contributed to your life? And a follow up, how are you supporting it and sharing the same with others?

We give back to God in gratitude with our time (volunteering), skills (cooking, organizing, carpentry, quilting/sewing, teaching, music, and so many more), and with money. By giving in these ways we say to God, “thank you.” We say, “You and this community are important to me.” And “I want this community to continue to exist.” It is not required, of course, but in response to God's love and the love we have for one another, we share what we can, when we can.

Out of thanksgiving to God, I serve God's people. And every opportunity I have I tell people about St. Paul and Immanuel to say, “look at the great things God is doing!”

Allow me to say, thank you, for the many and various ways you help support Immanuel and St. Paul Lutheran Churches and the ministry we do together in Dixon and beyond. Truly, thank you! I look forward to seeing how God shows up this year.
