



## **RULES OF CONDUCT IN CULTURAL AREAS**

Istanbul is a city with a rich cultural and natural heritage. To preserve this heritage and pass it on to future generations, visitors must pay attention to certain points.

### **Rules of Conduct in Cultural Areas**

- Remain quiet in museums and historical buildings and do not disturb other visitors.
- Do not invade the privacy of other visitors when taking photos and videos.
- Do not touch prohibited objects in museums and historical buildings.
- Do not smoke or eat in museums and historical buildings.
- Do not leave trash in museums and historical buildings.

### **Rules of Conduct in Natural Areas**

- Help preserve natural areas.
- Do not harm plants and animals.
- Throw your trash in trash cans.

- Do not light fires.
- Remain quiet and do not disturb other visitors.

Detailed explanations of the rules:

### Code of Conduct in Cultural Areas

Remain quiet in museums and historical buildings and do not disturb other visitors. Museums and historical buildings often have rules in place to prevent visitors from remaining quiet and disturbing other visitors. These rules are intended to help visitors maximize their experience.
