



Nuclear Consultation Discussion Points NEI 2026 RP-Forum

 - Overview of NRC inspections, performance indicators, and issue screening
 - Navigating the Significance Determination Process (SDP) for radiation safety
- D. Hands-on application of industry operating experience (OE)

2. On-site support for NRC / ANI / WANO – INPO Assist Visits

Assist clients in the development and preparation for regulatory reviews by the NRC and or other national or international regulatory authorities or assist agencies. This includes readiness reviews for inspections and internal or external assessments.
