



2026 BLACK MOUNTAINS CLASSIC TOUR

Supplementary Regulations

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Brecon Motor Club Ltd will promote The Black Mountains Classic Tour (Touring Assembly) on Sunday 13th September 2026, starting from Llangors Lake.

2. JURISDICTION

This Touring Assembly will be held under the Motorsport UK National Competition Rules (NCR's) incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, along with these supplementary regulations plus any other written instructions given by the organisers.

3. PERMIT

A Certificate of Exemption (COE) number 207119 has been issued by Motor Sport UK and this will be displayed on the official notice board at the start.

4. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to three and four wheeled cars manufactured up to 1991. Other cars of interest may be accepted at the organisers' discretion.

Entries are open to anyone with an appropriate classic car in addition to members of Brecon Motor Club, the HRCR and WAMC affiliated club members.

The event is a part of the 2026 HRCR Scenic Tour Series supported by Monit.

- All drivers must hold a valid driving licence (a competition licence is not required).
- All cars must have a valid V5C Registration Document,
- All cars must be taxed for use on the public highway (where applicable).
- All cars must carry a valid MOT certificate (where applicable)
- REMINDER – There is no competitive element to this event.

5. ENTRIES

- Entries are open from the publication of these regulations and close on Sunday 6th September 2026.
- The entry fee of £135 will include a "Tulip" style road book, a tour plate (to be affixed to the front of the vehicle) and a participant's award. Refreshments and sustenance is also included- bacon bap together with tea and coffee for participants at the start, plus morning coffee, tea and biscuits at morning halt, tea, coffee and cakes at the lunch halt and a hot dinner at the finish. Additional passengers will be accepted at a cost of £40 per person.
- Payment must be made by Bank Transfer to Brecon Motor Club account: Sort code 30-99-50 and the Account number is 46400268.
- All entries must be made through the 'Rallies Info Services' website via this link:

Entries WILL NOT be accepted by telephone, post or e-mail.

- e. The maximum number of cars will be 60 (excluding reserves) and the minimum 40. Should the minimum number of 40 entries not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and return any received entries.
- f. Cancellations prior to the event must be made in writing. Entry fees will be refunded up to the closing date, less a £30 administration fee. Refunds after this date will be subject to a decision by the Clerk of the Course.
- g. Any entrant whose driving standards is deemed not to be within the spirit of the event may be denied entry to future events. Entries may be refused without a reason being given.

6. EVENT ROUTE

- a. **START** The Lake Café, Llangors, Brecon, Powys, LD3 7TR.

- b. **FINISH** The Old Railway Line Garden Centre, Three Cocks, Powys, LD3 0SG.

- c. Your route will be provided in an easy to follow “Tulip” road book.
The complete route illustrated on 1:50,000 scale OS Landranger series maps will also be displayed at the start with the locations of fuel stations marked.
- d. The route will use roads on OS Landranger (1:50,000 scale) sheets number 136, 147, 148, 160 and 161, with a total mileage of 130.
The organiser’s mileages will be deemed as accurate and correct.
- e. Entrants are to be advised that the whilst the majority of the route uses roads that allow two-way traffic some roads are single carriageway and care and courtesy should be taken with regards to other road users and pedestrians.
- f. To confirm entrants have traversed the prescribed route there may be code boards placed along the route that will need to be recorded together with manned passage controls.
- g. Whilst this is not a timed event entrants may be requested to wait at manned passage and major controls to allow the event to maintain reasonable spaced gaps between cars.
- h. You are advised that you should endeavour to have a full tank of fuel before arrival at the start as there are no fuel stations in the vicinity of Llangors. There are a number of fuel stations NEAR the route and listed in the road book.
- i. All finishers that have completed the event will be presented with a commemorative award.

- a. It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure that the vehicle is taxed, road legal and insured for the purpose being used and all drivers are included on the insurance policy.
- b. The organisers have the right to exclude any vehicle deemed inappropriate or unsafe.
- c. Cars may not carry any advertising graphics or 'door competition numbers' unless by previous agreement by the organisers.
- d. Entrants will be issued with road books, rally plates and route check cards at signing on.
- e. A rally plate will be provided to be affixed to the car in a forward-facing position.

10. PROTESTS

Protests are not in the spirit of this type of event, therefore the decision of the organisers is final and absolute.

11. ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY
