A Journey Along the South Coast: 9 Days of Discovery

Day 1	Wednesday 4th November	Northern Rivers-Muswellbrook	LD
Your adventure begins as you journey south through the lush Northern Rivers region, pausing in Drake to enjoy morning tea among peaceful forest surroundings. Continuing onward, you make your way to the charming New England town of Uralla for lunch before winding through rural landscapes toward Muswellbrook. Upon arrival, settle into The Remington, Muswellbrook and later enjoy a relaxing dinner to end your first day on the road.

Day 2	Thursday 5th November	Muswellbrook-Canberra	BLD
Travel through the scenic Upper Hunter and rolling southern highlands as you make your way toward Canberra. The journey reveals open plains, historic townships, and ever-changing vistas before you arrive at the Garden City Best Western to unwind for the night.

Day 3	Friday 6th November	Queanbeyan-Eden via Cooma	BLD
	The day starts with a scenic drive toward the coast, heading first to the Snowy Hydro —a testament to Australia’s engineering feats. After exploring, you journey on, the countryside shifting as you head toward Bega , a town famous for its cheese. Stop for lunch at the Bega Cheese Heritage Centre , where local flavours and rich history blend together. In the afternoon, you reach the tranquil town of Eden , where the next four nights await. The evening is yours to unwind, with dinner at your accommodation.

Day 4	Saturday 7th November	Eden Sightseeing	BLD
Today is all about the sea and its stories. Set off on a cruise across Twofold Bay , where the waters shimmer and dolphins often play in the distance. Back on land, indulge in some of Eden’s freshest seafood with a fish & chips lunch , and then explore the Eden Killer Whale Museum , where tales of the region’s whaling past come to life. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of the town, learning about Eden’s whaling history and the natural beauty that surrounds it. Return to your motel to relax before dinner.			
Day 5	Sunday 8th November	Mallacoota	BLD
Today takes you south across the border into Victoria . In Mallacoota , a town virtually destroyed by bushfires in 2020, enjoy a morning tea overlooking the calm, reflective waters of the inlet. Then, explore the WW2 Operations Bunker , an intriguing piece of Australian history. Afterward, settle in for a hearty lunch at the Mallacoota Hotel before heading back to Eden. The afternoon is free for exploration, whether that means a leisurely walk or simply relaxing by the sea. Dinner in Eden rounds off another perfect day.			
Day 6	Monday 9th November	Merimbula	BLD
This morning, your journey leads you along the coast to Bermagui , where a scenic stop offers beautiful views. Continue to Tathra and Tura Beach , two peaceful coastal towns with hidden gems along their shorelines. Your journey then takes you to Merimbula , where a leisurely lunch awaits, followed by an afternoon stroll around the township. As the sun sets, head back to Eden to end the day with another delicious dinner and a quiet night.			
Day 7	Tuesday 10th November	Eden-Berry	BD
Today’s drive takes you through scenic inland routes and historic villages. First stop: Central Tilba , a village frozen in time, perfect for a stroll. Afterward, pass through Narooma before reaching Batemans Bay , where a stroll by the water is followed by lunch (purchase own). Continue north, arriving in the charming town of Berry , a perfect blend of heritage, food, and boutique shopping. Dinner at the Berry Hotel is a highlight.

Day 8	Wednesday 11th November	Berry-Old Bar	BLD
Start your day with the spectacular Sea Cliff Bridge , one of Australia’s most iconic coastal drives, before stopping at Stanwell Tops Lookout for breathtaking views of the coastline. Continuing north, enjoy lunch at The Yard Brewery & Smokehouse in Morisset , where craft beer and smoked meats make for a memorable meal. The road leads you next to Old Bar , a relaxed coastal town where you’ll unwind with a pleasant dinner at Club Old Bar.

Day 9	Thursday 12th November	Old Bar-Home	BL
On the final leg of your journey, make a stop at Kempsey Riverside Park , where the Macleay River flows gently by. Then, head to Grafton , where a choice of charming pubs offers the perfect place to stop for lunch. After lunch, it’s time to hit the road one last time and make your way home, with memories of the South Coast and its unforgettable charm.
