Students in Grades K-8 wear the school uniform during the entire school year, beginning with the first day of school. Scout uniforms may be worn instead of the school uniform on the day of the Scout Meeting. Any other exceptions will be communicated by the Principal in advance. Plaid uniform items are available at Milagro School Uniforms and Goods. Other uniform items may be purchased at Milagro School Uniforms and Goods **or** any Department Store (Target, Walmart, Boscovs, etc.). Information regarding the school's uniform exchange will be forthcoming. **Check to see what we have available before heading out to shop!!!!** We have lots of plaid items and navy blue pants and shorts.

DRESS CODE

Girls' Uniforms:

- Traditional plaid uniform jumper (Grades K – 5)
- Traditional plaid uniform skort (Grades K – 5)
- Traditional plaid uniform skirt (Grades 6– 8 **ONLY**)
- Navy blue walking shorts (All Grades)
- Navy blue dress slacks (All Grades) – **No leggings**
- Navy blue polo/knit shirt – long or short sleeved (Grades 6 – 8)
- White polo/knit shirt or white blouse – long or short sleeved (Grades K – 5)
- White turtleneck (Grades K-5)
- Navy blue turtleneck (Grades 6-8)
- Navy blue – Cardigan, V-neck, or crew (All Grades)
- Navy blue School-logo sweatshirt (All Grades)
- Closed-toe dress shoes with a heel no higher than 1 inch- black, brown, navy blue (**plain, leather-style – no TOMs, Vans, or similar canvas-type shoes, no sneakers, no moccasins, no Crocs, no boots**)
- White or navy blue socks- ankle, crew or knee high (**no-show socks are not permitted, logos, stripes, or patterns are not permitted**)
- White or navy blue tights (**no leggings**)
- **Skirts, skorts, jumpers, and shorts must be fingertip length**

Boys Uniforms:

- Navy blue walking shorts (Grades K-5)
- Khaki walking shorts (Grades 6-8)
- Navy blue dress slacks (Grades K-5)

- Khaki dress slacks (Grades 6-8)
- White polo shirt- Long or short sleeved (Grades K-5)
- Light Blue Oxford Shirt – Long or short sleeved (Grades 6-8)
- White turtleneck (Grades K-5)
- Navy blue sweater- Cardigan, V-neck, or crew (All Grades)
- Navy blue School-logo sweatshirt (All Grades)
- Closed-toe dress shoes- black, brown, navy blue
(**plain, leather-style -- no TOMs, Vans, or similar canvas-type shoes, no sneakers, no moccasins, no Crocs**)
- White or navy blue socks- ankle or crew (**no-show socks are not permitted, logos, stripes, or patterns are not permitted**)

All Students: Shirts must be tucked in at all times unless a banded shirt is worn. Belts are required for Grades 5-8.

Physical Education Uniform: In order to participate in Physical Education classes, uniform gym clothing IS MANDATORY. Order information regarding gym uniforms will be sent home during the summer and at the beginning of the school year. **ALL Students** in Grades K-8 are required to wear a gym uniform. Students will wear their gym clothes to school on the day they are scheduled for gym class.

Hair - Boys: Male students are expected to have neatly trimmed hair that does not exceed the shirt collar and that does not impair one's vision. It is also expected that one's hair is of a natural color and styled in a tasteful and appropriate fashion. Extreme hair styles are not permitted.

Hair - Girls: Female students are expected to have neatly styled hair that does not impair one's vision. It is also expected that one's hair is of a natural color and styled in a tasteful and appropriate fashion. Extreme hair styles are not permitted. **No novelty hair accessories – cat ear, unicorn headbands or large bows, are permitted.**

Make-up and Nail Polish: Female students in Grades 6-8 are permitted to wear minimal and tasteful make-up. Students wearing an abundance of make-up or make-up that is very dark will be required to remove it. Female students are also permitted to wear lightly colored nail polish. Students wearing dark or very bright colored nail polish will be required to remove it. No acrylic/fake nails are permitted.

Jewelry - Boys: The following accessories are acceptable: Wrist watch, a thin bracelet (not dangly or stretchy), one ring, and a thin gold or silver chain (remaining inside of shirt). Male students are not permitted to wear earrings of any kind.

Jewelry - Girls: The following accessories are acceptable: Wrist watch, a thin bracelet (not dangly or stretchy), one ring, a thin gold or silver chain (remaining inside of shirt), and stud-style earrings. Girls are not permitted to wear hoop or dangling earrings.

All Students: Students are not permitted to wear facial jewelry of any kind including nose, lip or eye brow piercing.

Casual/Dress Down Day

Throughout the year, on designated days, students are permitted to dress casually. Students are often asked to donate at least \$1.00 for this privilege of dressing casually. The monies collected are donated to a local charity, mission, or other worthy causes.

All shorts, skirts and dresses must be no shorter than fingertip length.

Shirts and dresses must have sleeves (no tank tops, spaghetti straps or mid-riff /crop top shirts).

Tight fitting shirts or dresses are not permitted. Open-toe or open back shoes are not permitted.
(No Crocs)

No leggings. No excessively ripped or torn clothing.

Pictures, logos and messages on clothing should be appropriate for a Catholic School.

Failure to comply with the dress code will result in dress down privileges being revoked.
