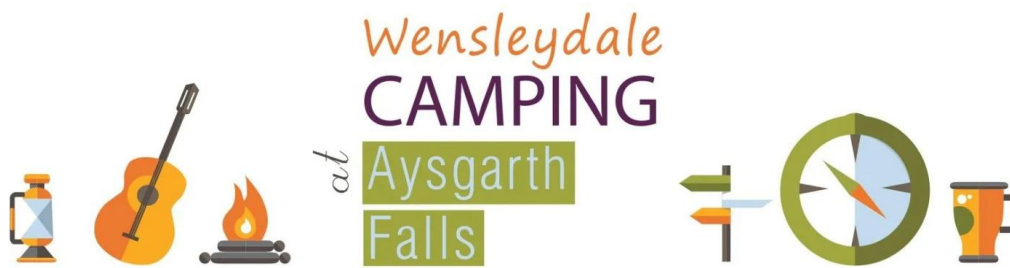

2 CODE OF CONDUCT

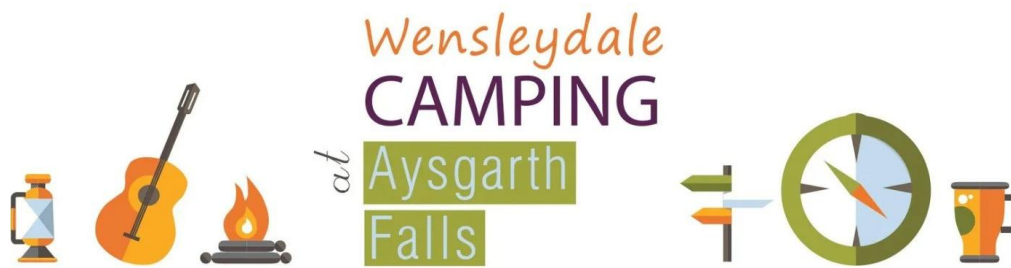
Purpose: We are deeply committed to respecting nature and preserving this beautiful environment for all our campers to enjoy, so we have a few important rules in place to help protect the woodland wildlife and ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable stay 😊

🌲 Please Do Not:

1. ❌ Carve or cause damage to trees or their bark
2. ❌ Bring axes, saws, large knives or metal detectors – these are strictly not allowed
3. ❌ Climb trees or hang swings
4. ❌ Discard litter, especially glass. Any broken glass **must be** reported to ensure it is fully removed from site
5. ❌ Interfere with stones from the old 'fallen walls' of historic strip farming
6. ❌ Bring/ use amplifiers/play music too loud

🌲 Please Do:

1. ✅ Freely wander and enjoy the woodland, relax and absorb nature
2. ✅ Enjoy the marvel of an open fire, toast marshmallows, cook dinner or BBQ
3. ✅ Stay up late telling campfire tales and marvel at the dark skies
4. ✅ Observe the diverse natural wildlife including rabbits, pheasants, hedgehogs, deer, woodpecker, birds of prey, ducks
5. ✅ Explore the incredible waterfalls Aysgarth Falls within only a few minutes walk.
6. ✅ Hang a hammock!
7. ✅ Play or listen to music, always respectful towards fellow Campers
8. ✅ Allow children to explore the woodland with adventures like Hide and Seek, treasure hunt and discovering nature



3 FIRE PIT RULES

Purpose: Our fire pit rules are in place to help keep everyone safe and to maintain the natural beauty of the woodland. Fire pits are a central part of the experience – but safety and conservation are key! 😊

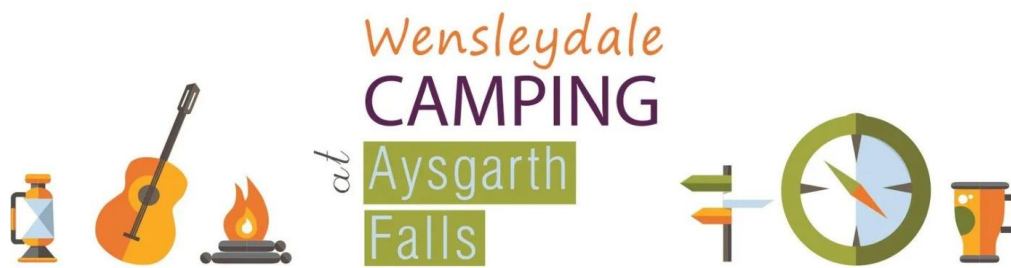
🔥 Please Do Not:

1. ❌ Move or alter the fire pit size
 2. ❌ Add extra stones or remove them from other fire pits
 3. ❌ Place stones in the fire (they can crack and explode)
 4. ❌ Burn tin cans, glass, bottle tops, plastic or scrap wood – only ash to be left in the fire pit

4 LOGS & FUEL

Purpose: We share log and kindling details to help you plan ahead and keep fires safe. Using only approved fuel protects the woodland and ensures a clean, safe burn 😊

- **Logs** are available to buy from us at **£15 per bag (approx 15Kg)**. They are kiln-dried, netted and ready to burn. **Coal, Kindling and firelighters** are also available to buy. They will be provided at the woodland for you on arrival. ⚠️ **Please order** in advance to ensure availability. Most Campers use **1.5 bags per day/night**.
- ✅ You may bring your own logs, but strictly ❌ no pallets, scrap timber with nails, metal or treated wood, or larger than 30cm in length.
- ❌ You must not forage for wood from the woodland other than ✅ twigs/small whips found lying loose on the woodland floor. No cutting, snapping of trees/branches.



5 CAMP WASTE

Purpose: Our waste policy requires all campers to take their rubbish home to help keep the woodland pristine. Leaving no trace protects the environment and ensures a clean, natural space for everyone to enjoy. 😊

♻️ Please Do:

1. Kindly take all rubbish home with you – strong bin bags are advised to ensure no breakage or leaks. ⚠️ There will not be any bins or waste disposal facilities on site.
2. Ensure you take all camp equipment home with you, particularly check for tent pegs left in the ground!

6 COMPOST TOILETS

Purpose: As part of our commitment to an authentic, back-to-nature experience we provide basic essential toilet facilities – environmentally friendly compost loos only. This low-impact approach helps preserve the natural beauty and ecological balance of the woodland. 😊

- ✅ 'Festival style' compost toilets provided. Remember to bring antibacterial gel/wipes for hand cleansing.
- ❌ **Please Do Not put non-biodegradable wipes or sanitary products into the compost toilet, they do not decompose.**
- ✅ **Instead, please place them in the dedicated bin provided.**
- **Please Do** bring your own toilet roll, this ensures minimal waste and maximum hygiene standards.



7 WATER

Purpose: We ask campers to bring their own drinking water to ensure personal health and hygiene during their stay. Providing your own supply helps maintain safe and sanitary conditions across the woodland campsite 😊

- **Please Do** bring your own supply of drinking, washing and cooking water for the duration of your stay. ⚠️ There will not be a supply of drinking water in the woodland.
- 💧 Campers typically bring 5-litre bottles purchased from most supermarkets.

8 GENERAL T&C's

Purpose: Our general terms and conditions are designed to ensure the safety, comfort, and enjoyment of everyone staying with us. By setting a few simple expectations, we help create a peaceful and respectful camping environment for all 😊

1. Full payment for your stay must be made **prior to** arrival, thank you in advance 😊
2. **Please note** that we do not accept any liability for personal injury, loss, or damage to personal belongings during your stay. Campers are responsible for their own safety and possessions at all times while on site.
3. For Group bookings, **the Group Lead is responsible** for ensuring all Campers have read, understood and abide by our Camp Policies during your stay.
4. We must be provided with a full list of Campers names prior to your stay, this helps keep a record of 'head count' for safety purposes. 🗣️
5. ⚠️ All children under 18 **must be** supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
6. Respectfully, camper vans/caravans/motor bikes are not permitted.
7. We love dogs, however to protect the woodland wildlife dogs are not allowed.
