

Saint Report

1st year Confirmation candidates are asked to do research on saints and find one that they admire and/or look to for inspiration. This saint will become their chosen Saint for their Confirmation Name. Candidates are asked to type at least a one-page, double spaced report about the Saint. The report may include things like:

- **A brief summary on the life of the Saint.**
- **Why did you decide to choose this Saint?**
- **Does the Saint play a significance in your life right now?**
- **Why was the Saint holy?**
- **Why were they canonized a Saint?**
- **What do you have in common or hope to have in common with the Saint?**

10th grade candidates must complete and submit their Saint Reports by Mar. 31st.

If a candidate decides to use their own given name as their Confirmation name, they must still research a saint and write a report. The paper can be scanned and e-mailed to nstewart@shepherdsouls.org or mailed or hand-delivered to the Faith Formation Office.

NOTE: While AI may be used as part of the research process (though this is discouraged), candidates must submit their own work. AI plagiarism will not be tolerated, nor plagiarism in any form.
