



Coaches Code of Conduct

As an Oregon Youth Softball Coach I will:

- Represent my team, Oregon Youth Softball, and the community of Oregon, WI in a positive manner.
- Foster a healthy sports environment by refraining from drugs, alcohol, and tobacco use during all sporting events.

Practice, Games, and Tournaments:

- Coaches will hold regular practices to ensure that all players are receiving complete instruction and appropriate training.
- Coaches will arrive on time to practices, games, and tournaments
- Coaches will come to practices, games, and tournaments organized.
- Coaches will know what they are doing ahead of time by way of having a practice plan, so as to minimize chaos and minimize players just standing around.
- Coaches will have a detailed plan for substitutions in advance of all games.
- Coaches will institute fair play by playing all players in the infield and outfield during all games.
- Coaches will institute fair sitting / time on bench policies; all players should be rotated in and out of play during the course of games and tournaments.
- Coaches will assist with developing appropriate athletic skills for each age level.
- Coaches will help to develop the confidence, self-esteem, and physical fitness levels of all players.
- Coaches will encourage team spirit and camaraderie.
- Coaches will praise the effort, not the result.
- Coaches will emphasize having fun, getting better at the fundamentals, and maintaining a positive competitive spirit
- Coaches will be responsible for the behavior of the assistant coaches, players and parents, and for subsequent discipline during all team activities.
- Coaches will be positive role models, establish fair play guidelines, and exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.
- Coaches will not argue with umpires or fans / parents.

Communication:

- Coaches will hold at least one in person parent meeting.
- Coaches will communicate with players in a direct and positive manner.
- Coaches will communicate with parents in a direct and positive manner.
- Coaches will communicate with each other in a direct and positive manner.
