Attitude

- Have a positive outlook on going to practice and being around my teammates and coaches.

Practice

- Be on time and prepared, with all the necessary equipment I need.
- Work hard to understand the rules of the game at the level I am playing at.

Games

- Be positive and keep perspective. Be humble and gracious in victory, but proud and courteous in defeat.
- Be aggressive and play hard, but in a way that does not cause injury to myself or my opponent.
