- Qualifications

- Hiring Process and Background Check
- Training Programs
- Insurance and licenses
- Commercial references

These main topics will help you to understand if the cleaning company can provide the services that your business requires and if you will request a proposal from that specific cleaning company.



#### Seek eco-friendly practices

- Inquire about the cleaning company's environmental practices and if sustainability is important to your organization.
- Ask if they use green cleaning products and techniques that minimize their impact on the environment.







#### Request proposals

- After you collect the data from a long supplier list through an RFI and select the most reliable ones to attend your company/business, it's time to request your Proposal through an RFQ (request for Quote) or RFP (Request for Proposal).
- Your RFQ or RFP must have a clear and concise statement of work describing the activities to be done during the service contract, the number of full or part-time resources (if you have it), a pricing worksheet with information about resources and their time allocation and pricing and additional costs.



#### Conduct interviews and site visits

- Schedule interviews with shortlisted companies to assess their expertise, professionalism, and responsiveness.
- Visit their current clients' sites to see the quality of their work firsthand.







#### Negotiate and revise contract terms

- Depending on the size of the business, make multiple rounds of negotiation. It can be related to pricing, KPIs or even technology to support the services.
- Review the contract terms and ensure they are aligned with your expectations.
- Pay attention to details such as the duration of the contract, cancellation policies, and any guarantees or warranties provided.



#### Regularly evaluate performance

- Establish clear communication channels and regularly evaluate the cleaning company's performance through the KPIs established in the contract.
- Provide feedback and address any concerns promptly to maintain a high standard of cleanliness in your facility.
