

# CCP: College Credit Plus Information Sheet

## General Information for All Ohio Students

**WHAT:** College Credit Plus is an Ohio program that can help students in grades 7-12 earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from Ohio colleges and universities.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options to college-ready students.

**COST:** Taking a college course from a public college or university is free. That means no cost for tuition, books or fees. If a student chooses to attend a private college or university, a family may have limited costs. Note: If a student withdraws from a course after an add/drop date specified by CCP or does not pass the course, the parents must assume responsibility for the cost of that course.

## Specific Information for Heartland Students

**TUITION:** A family receives a tuition discount of 5% (maximum of 15%) per semester for each three (3) semester hour CCP course that the student successfully completes. If the student does not pass the course, the student's family will not receive the discount.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Should a student opt to take CCP courses on the college campus, his/her family is responsible for transportation arrangements to and from the college.

**TEXTBOOKS:** HCS will loan required textbooks to its CCP students. HCS purchases or rents such textbooks for students to use while taking CCP courses. As such, textbooks must be returned in the condition they were issued on or before the date specified at the onset of the semester. Note: The cost of issued textbooks will become the responsibility of the parents if textbooks are not returned when due and/or in a condition less than what was issued to the CCP student.

**CREDIT:** CCP students will earn both high school and college credit for the courses successfully completed (earning a grade of C or better) through the university. One (1) high school credit will be awarded for the successful completion of a three (3) or more semester hour college course.

**GPA POINTS:** The number of quality points awarded for CCP courses will be the same as what is awarded to students taking AP classes, i.e., A (including A-) = 4.3 quality points, B (including B-) = 3.3 quality points, and C (including C-) = 2.3 quality points.
