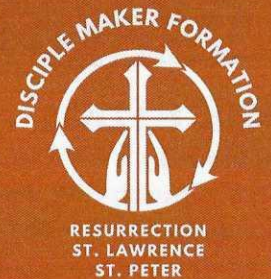

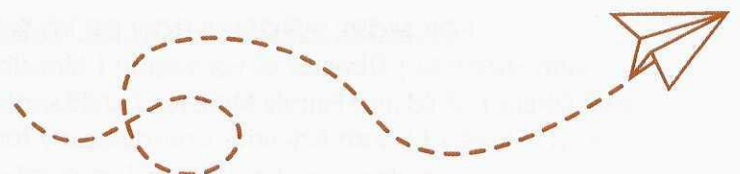

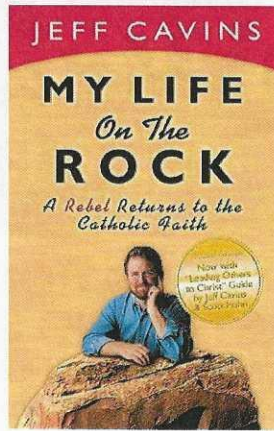
Resuming September 8th

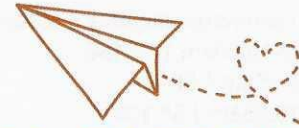
OPENING THE WORD

On September 29, we remember the archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael — heavenly messengers who share God's insight with us.

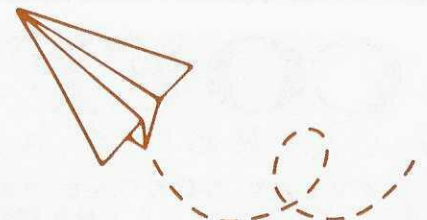
CANS FOR CHARITY
