Featured in this segment are John D. Rockefeller’s Kykuit Estate, the villas of Robert Wilson Goelet’s Glenmere Estate and Charles E. Rushmore Canmore Estate, Pierre Lorillard IV’s Tuxedo Park, Col. Oliver Hazard Payne’s West Park Estate, and the Livingston Legacy of Staatsburgh.

About the speaker: A graduate of Marist College with degrees in Hudson River Valley history and public administration, Alex Prizgintas has published articles in the *Hudson River Valley Review*, *New York Archives Magazine*, and *Orange County Historical Society Journal* on topics such as Hudson River railroad history, Orange County’s dairy farming history, and the region’s early settlers.
