Pageant Information & Rules

Prince William County Fair Pageant - Important Information

- Teen and Miss Contestants will compete in Interview, Personality Wear, and Gown categories.
- They will also participate in an opening number (not judged).
- Gowns should be long and age appropriate.
- Personality Wear should be non-glitz and represent individuality.
- Interview attire: dress or business/interview attire.
- Wardrobe questions should be directed to Pageant Directors.

Pre-Teen, Little Miss, Tiny Miss, Baby Miss, Wee Baby, and Teeny Baby Contestants will compete in runway wear.

- NO PAGEANT ATTIRE.
- Outfits should feature summer attire (no swimsuits), "off the rack."
- Shoes can include flats, sneakers, etc.
- Judging will be based on personality.

Optional Photogenic for all age divisions (not included in competition score).

Photos must be turned in at Orientation.

Registration Fee is non-refundable.

- Make checks payable to Prince William County Fair.
- Pageant will be held rain or shine.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Contestants must be single, never married, without children, and never have been married or pregnant prior to or during their reign.
- 2. Must be female and have been born female.
- 3. Never have been convicted of a crime or any pending criminal charges or been engaged in any activity that could be characterized as dishonest, immoral, immodest or indecent.
- 4. Winners must participate in events/activities requested by pageant officials.
- 5. Winners may not enter other pageants during their reign without written permission.



- 6. Unsportsmanlike behavior by contestant or family/friends will lead to disqualification.
- 7. Pageant reserves the right to change rules as necessary.
- 8. Judges' decisions are final.
- 9. Winners must follow rules/regulations during their reign.
- 10. Age group Queens/Kings must participate in Prince William County Fair events.
- 11. The Miss contestant will advance to the **Virginia Association of Fair State**Pageant.
 - a. This requires extensive preparation.
 - b. Assistance will be provided, but contestant **must be willing and available**.
 - c. Failure to comply results in forfeiture of title to 1st runner-up.
- 12. Miss and Teen contestants will have a 5-minute interview.
- 13. Titleholders must conduct themselves **appropriately**, including online activity.
 - d. Social media (Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, etc.) must be tasteful.
 - e. One warning will be issued for infractions; further issues result in **immediate forfeiture** of title.
