Identity Theft

"Identity theft" is a huge problem during the holidays, with estimated losses running somewhere in between \$12.5 and \$47 billion per year. As technology and AI become more sophisticated, these figures are expected to increase. That's the bad news. The good news is, this article has nothing to do with computer hacking. It has to do with our identity as the only Christian Church to be instituted by Jesus. It has to do with taking stock of the way we celebrate the holidays.... as Catholics

In this case, it's a good idea to start with Christmas, because that should be fresh in our mind.

According to historical record, early Christians believed that Jesus was born on or near Dec. 25. This was determined by using temple records that showed the date when Zechariah was assigned to enter the Holy of Holies, then triangulated with the birth of his son, John the Baptist, who Luke says was 6 months older than Jesus. As a church, this date was not celebrated, at first, because they thought their emphasis should be on the Lord's resurrection. The Church officially adopted the date and celebrated universally, around 336 A.D. in Rome and for the next 1300 years, it was exclusively a Catholic practice. After the protestants broke away, England banned the celebration for about 16 years, thinking it was too "Catholic". Christmas was also banned for a short while in Massachusetts with violators being fined 5 shillings if caught celebrating it. Even after that ordinance was repealed, Christmas was not held in high regard among our separated brethren. In early America, making a big deal out of Christmas was one of the ways that people knew who the Catholics were.

In 1870, Christmas became a U.S. federal holiday when President Ulysses S. Grant signed legislation making December 25 the day we celebrate it nationally. Big business recognized the holiday's commercial potential, and exploited it into the \$1.2 trillion industry we have today. That's a lot of money, with most of it being spent on activities that have nothing to do with the Lord's birth. So, what was once a Catholic celebration, has been co-opted to celebrate greed and over-indulgence.

This, in and of itself, should be of concern for Christians everywhere, but what makes it worse is when Catholics try to fit in with society, and abandon our own practices to follow the way of secular Christmas. It's almost as if we've had our identity stolen because in order for us to be "one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic" (we say this in our Creed), we have to be holy, which means "set apart". This is a part of our identity that, we are in danger of losing.

While it's true, that we still come to church and attend Mass. And, of course we still pray as usual, aside from a few flurries of activity that are exclusive to our Catholic faith, i.e..... Our Lady of Guadalupe presentations, the Posadas, and the Filipino Lantern Procession, it has become difficult to distinguish between worldly and Catholic observance of the season leading up to Christmas and the season itself.

After all, many of us were there for "Black Friday", most of us call the season Christmas, when it's actually Advent (to Catholic to say in public?), and too many of us partied and feasted in excess, before the feast actually got here. With that said, it's starting to look like the holidays are "on the ropes" and, if that's the case, it is long past time, for us to rediscover and herald the difference it makes, being Catholic. That means, busting out the Epiphany Chalk, keeping the lights on and celebrating until the Epiphany or even extending until February 2, eating seven kinds of fish, and using Google to search for exclusively Catholic practices from the past that will recapture and enhance the celebration.

Extending that into the future, Lent will be here soon enough, followed by Easter. These holidays have been subject to the same secular stripping as Christmas and Hallows Eve. That being so, now is the time to start studying, planning, and preparing to stand apart from the world, give the bunny and his eggs the boot, then give Easter back to the Lord, for His Church, and for the next generation. In this way, let us reclaim our identity and show Jesus our gratitude by making His celebrations Catholic again.

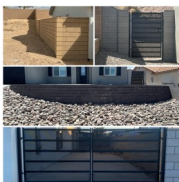

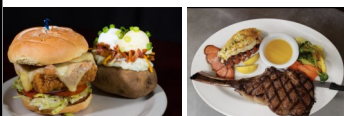
