Parish Maintenance Update October 2025

Here's an update on all our maintenance projects. The project that I thought would be the first to be completed looks like it will be the last, and that would be the sound absorbing panels for our church. There is always something that takes longer than originally planned. We chose the color this past Spring. There was not an exact match for our walls, so we chose the best color available to blend into our walls, but it won't be perfect. The panels will be in the transepts and on the back wall above the choir loft.

We need to replace the CFL lightbulbs with LED lightbulbs in all the chandeliers in the church. The CFL lightbulbs are no longer being made, so we cannot replace those lightbulbs as they burn out. That project needs to happen in the next few years.

We should be done with all the landscaping improvements. There should not be any major landscaping projects for a long time. At this point, we will maintain what we have.

All the painting projects have been completed, so we should not need to paint any of the buildings for a while.

It appears all the leaks in our roofs have been fixed, so that is a blessing. The last leak was in our office, and that was fixed a few months ago.

The bathrooms in the parish hall need some work. That is something we should address in the next few years. The projector in the parish hall stopped working a few months ago. About a week ago someone donated a projector to the parish along with the cables and the mounting brackets.

The chapel in our original church is mostly finished. We ordered metal doors for the south side of the building since the original wood doors are deteriorating. Those should be installed in the next few weeks. The pews need to be reupholstered. We are still trying to figure out how we want to do that. The storage room behind the chapel needs dry wall to be installed on that side of the wall. The drywall has been purchased and delivered. It will be installed in the next few months.

The asphalt in driveway to Booster Drive will not be replaced at this time. We will look at the possibility of doing maintenance that will extend its life. It has deteriorated over the years, but it should be drivable for many more years.

The air conditioning in the church has been a big headache for the last two years. We had not been able to find anyone who could work on our two huge HVAC units. The company that used to drive up from Phoenix is no longer in business, and there is no one locally who works on them. The huge unit on the southside has not been working for two years, and a few months ago, the huge unit on the northside began giving us problems. It doesn't want to turn on. When we get it to turn on, it blows cold air, but it does not want to turn on.

A few months ago, the gentleman who works on our smaller HVAC units encountered a tech from Las Vegas who works on the huge units, so we finally have progress, but it has been very expensive. They got the south unit started and diagnosed what is wrong with it. The estimate for that repair is \$11,000. We need to pay it. If you want to donate toward that repair, that would be wonderful. They worked on the north unit and have one more thing to work on because it still is giving us problems.

That's the update. We are caught up on most of the maintenance. It takes money to maintain our campus. Please consider increasing your donation to our parish so that we can do all the required maintenance on our campus. At the same time, we also owe a little more than \$2,500,000 on our construction loan, so please do not decrease what you are giving to that. Thank you for your generosity and your patience. Fr. Dan

Actualización de mantenimiento parroquial de octubre de 2025

Aquí hay una actualización de todos nuestros proyectos de mantenimiento. El proyecto que pensé que sería el primero en completarse parece que será el último, y esos serían los paneles absorbentes de sonido para nuestra iglesia. Siempre hay algo que lleva más tiempo de lo planeado. Elegimos el color la primavera pasada. No había un color exacto para nuestras paredes, por lo que elegimos el mejor color disponible para combinar con nuestras paredes, pero no será perfecto. Los paneles estarán en las paredes de los transeptos y en la pared posterior sobre el coro.

Necesitamos reemplazar las bombillas CFL con bombillas LED en todos los candelabros de la iglesia. Las bombillas CFL ya no se fabrican, por lo que no podemos reemplazar esas bombillas cuando dejan de funcionar. Ese proyecto sucederá en los próximos años.

Hemos terminado con todas los trabajos del embellecimiento de nuestra propiedad. No debería haber proyectos grandes de embellecimiento de nuestra propiedad por el tiempo. En este momento, mantendremos lo que tenemos.

Todos los proyectos de pintura se han completado, por lo que no deberíamos necesitar pintar ninguno de los edificios por un tiempo.

Al parecer todos nuestros techos han sido reparados, así que eso es una bendición. El último techo que estaba goteando fue el techo de la oficina, y fue reparado hace unos meses.

Los baños en el salón parroquial necesitan algo de trabajo. Eso es algo que deberíamos de arreglar en los próximos años. El proyector del salón parroquial dejó de funcionar hace unos meses. Hace aproximadamente una semana, alguien donó un proyector a la parroquia junto con los cables y los soportes.

La capilla de nuestra iglesia original está casi terminada. Ordenamos puertas de metal para el lado sur del edificio ya que las puertas originales de madera se están deteriorando. Se instalarán en las próximas semanas. Las bancas necesitan ser tapizadas de nuevo. Todavía estamos tratando de averiguar cómo lo queremos hacer. Necesitamos terminar la pared del lado del almacén detrás de la capilla. Ya hemos comprado el material. Terminaremos la pared en los próximos meses.

El asfalto de la entrada de Booster Drive no será reemplazado en este momento. Estamos viendo como lo podemos arreglar sin tener que reemplázalo. Se ha deteriorado con los años, pero todavía funcionara por muchos años más.

El aire acondicionado de la iglesia ha sido un gran dolor de cabeza durante los últimos dos años. No habíamos podido encontrar a nadie que pudiera trabajar en nuestras dos unidades HVAC. La compañía que venia desde Phoenix ha cerrado y no hay nadie local que pueda darles servicio. La unidad en el lado sur no ha estado funcionando durante dos años, y hace unos meses, la unidad en el lado norte comenzó a darnos problemas. No quiere prender. Cuando conseguimos que prenda, sopla aire frío, pero no quiere prenderse.

Hace unos meses, el señor que trabaja en nuestras unidades HVAC más pequeñas se encontró con un técnico de Las Vegas que trabaja en las unidades que tenemos, por lo que finalmente tenemos progreso, pero ha sido muy costoso. Pusieron en marcha la unidad en el lado sur y pudieron encontrar el problema. Nos dieron un estimado de \$11,000 para poder repararla. Si desea donar para esa reparación, se lo agradecemos. Han estado trabajando en la unidad en el norte y todavía tienen un problema que necesita ser reparado porque todavía nos está dando problemas.

Esa es la actualización. Estamos al día con la mayor parte del mantenimiento. Se necesita dinero para mantener nuestra propiedad. Considere aumentar su donación a nuestra parroquia para que podamos hacer todo el mantenimiento requerido en nuestra propiedad. Al mismo tiempo, también debemos un poco más de \$ 2,500,000 en la hipoteca de nuestra nueva iglesia, así que no disminuya lo que está dando a eso. Gracias por su generosidad y su paciencia. 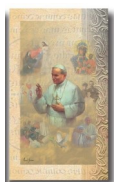

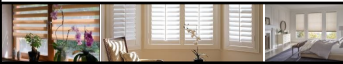

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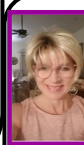
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
