33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time – YRC 2025

In our second reading, St. Paul is addressing the fact that some of the Thessalonians have stopped working because they believe that Jesus is coming back very soon. Thus, they had become lazy. Sloth is not a virtue, but a vice. That is not how to prepare to encounter our Lord.

On one occasion, a man in hospice care confessed to me that he wasted his retirement years. He regretted not doing a better job using the time that God had given him. However, I have encountered a lot of people who seem to be busier in their retirement years than they were before they retired. They are busy with the things that they enjoy. They are actively involved in the parish and in the community. We feel better when we are helping other people and building the Kingdom of God. Being actively involved also provides more opportunities to develop good relationships, which also leads to more happiness.

St. Paul also touches on an important aspect of charity. To help someone find work so that they can take care of themselves is far better than continually providing for their needs. As the saying goes, "Give someone a fish, and they will eat for a day, but teach the person to fish they will be fed for a lifetime." To give a microloan to someone in a third-world country so that they can start a small business is a better form of charity than to give them food every day.

We need to be careful that we don't judge those who need financial help. However, those who need financial help have the responsibility to do what they can to support themselves. We need to be generous with our time, talent, and treasure, and aware that the rising costs of food, housing, and healthcare are having a negative effect on those who have a fixed income. Our Lord was very clear, helping the least among us puts us on the path to heaven, but neglecting to help the least among us puts us on the path to eternal separation from God. (Matthew 25:31-46; Luke 16:19-31)

Today's gospel passage is reminding us of the meaning of this phrase that we say in the Creed every Sunday: "Jesus will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead." At our Lord's second coming, all the injustices of human history will be rectified once and for all. Those who refused His friendship, and ignored or abused their neighbor, will find no place in the redeemed world which they rejected. Those who carried their crosses with our Lord will be healed of every wound and given the fullness of life.

The Church has never claimed to know when Judgment Day will come. It could be today; it could be 1,000 years from now. Jesus himself told us that we can know "neither the day nor the hour" (Matt 24:36; Mark 13:32). So, if anyone ever tells you that they know the exact date, you can be sure that they are wrong.

But the Apostles, being curious like many of us, wanted to know dates and times, so they asked, "Teacher, when will this happen?" Jesus did not give a direct answer. Instead, He points out the three most critical facts about the future: First, He will return from heaven to bring to completion the eternal Kingdom that He founded through the Church. Second, in the meantime, He is sending His disciples, the Apostles, and the Christians of all ages, including us, to invite all people into that Kingdom. And third, although this mission will be challenged by suffering, humiliation, and opposition of all kinds, He will continue to work in and through His faithful followers by the power of the Holy Spirit.

This is privileged knowledge given by the Lord of life and history to us, His followers. It is exactly what we need to know about the future. It enables us to face life's inevitable hardships with confidence and joy, always staying focused on what really matters: following Jesus Christ, and helping others to follow Him.

In non-Christian cultures, there is an immense amount of interest in, and anxiety about the future. Unfortunately, the devil often tries to take this curiosity, and misuse it, creating an unhealthy desire to foresee and control the future. In fact, one sign that our culture is being de-Christianized is the growing interest in pagan, occult, and superstitious practices that falsely promise hidden knowledge and power over the future. We can find books about Tarot Cards, tea leaves, celestial prophecies, spiritism, Wicca, Magic, and other quick-fix cosmic control techniques. These practices, which are not Christian, have become socially acceptable, and even popular.

Unfortunately, going to witches is more common than it should be in the Hispanic culture. They are called brujerias. They claim to be good witches who want to help. However, there is no such thing as a good witch because they are invoking evil spirits who are always opposed to God, and always opposed to our eternal salvation. God brings order and healing into life, but evil spirits bring disorder and dysfunction. Inviting evil spirits into your life is always a disastrous and horrible idea.

Brujerias will even do spells against people you don't like. That is the complete opposite of Christianity. Jesus told us to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us (Matt 5:44). To purposely harm someone, puts us outside the kingdom of God. To dabble in witchcraft is to say, "My kingdom come, and my will be done," rather than praying to God as Jesus taught, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Thus, any use of the Ouija board, tarot cards, reading tea leaves, dabbling with the occult in any way, puts that person outside of the Kingdom of God, and firmly within Satan's Kingdom.

Jesus has already revealed to us everything we need to know about the future. And He has taught us everything we need to know about how to shape our future. Dabbling with the occult to try to find out more about our future is a slap in the face to God. It is breaking the very first commandment, which is to love and trust only the one, true God with all our heart. For some people, the teachings of Jesus are not as glamorous as the devil's lies. Following Jesus demands a bit more self-control than self-indulgence. But in the end, He brings life, and the devil brings death.

At a time that no one knows, Judgment Day is coming. Jesus is coming again. There will be an end to the battle between good and evil, and good will win. We know this. God has revealed it. The vast majority of humankind, throughout history and even today, do not know this. For those who do not know or believe in Christ, the future is a dark and threatening mystery. But for us, it is a coming victory.

Remembering that Christ knows the future, that He is the Lord of that future, that He is guiding all things to their proper end, and that nothing is out of range of His wisdom and power - this is one of the secrets to interior peace, to peace of mind. During every Mass, right after we pray the Our Father, the priest prays, "Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil, graciously grant peace in our days, that, by the help of your mercy, we may be always free from sin and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ."

Jesus revealed the future to us because He wants to give us courage. Since we know that His Kingdom will be victorious and last forever, we can be more energetic and confident in building His Kingdom. He tells his Apostles that they will be persecuted, but they are not to worry, since "it will lead to your giving testimony." This is what we are called to do - to tell others about Christ, to bring them into the Church, so that they too can reestablish an intimate friendship with God and set out on the path to eternal life. Jesus tells His Apostles that they will even be betrayed by family members, but it doesn't matter, because He will still be protecting them: "not a hair on your head will be destroyed." And so, He goes on to tell them, they should never give up in their efforts to follow Christ and help others follow him: "By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

As Christians, we are soldiers of Christ. We have been given a share in His mission. People around us are starving to know the future, the real truth about the future. That is why they are buying books about tea leaves, Tarot Cards, celestial prophecies, witchcraft, and magic. Jesus wants to save them from their anxiety and from the dangers of looking for answers in the wrong places. And He has invited us to be His messengers.

Since we know that Jesus is coming, and that we will be judged by Him not on how much money we made, nor on how many diplomas we earned, nor even on how popular we were, but simply striving with the grace of God to live a virtuous life, to love Christ and serve our neighbor, we can be at peace - if we are making that effort. This puts all our worries into their proper place.

This earth is passing away. Until it does, we are called to use each day to love God and neighbor. That is all we need to know about the future and the present. That should bring comfort and relief. Do not fear the future. If we spend our lives doing our best to live a virtuous and moral life, and loving God and neighbor we are going to be okay. That is the comforting news that our friends and family members need to hear.
