First Sunday of Advent - YRA 2025

Our first reading speaks about people streaming to God in order to be instructed by Him. The result of the people allowing themselves to be instructed by God is that they walk in His ways. They live a life of holiness, love, mercy, forgiveness, and virtue. The result of living like that is that nations no longer want to go to war against each other, and weapons are turned into tools for farming. It is a peace that is more than an absence of war. It is a peace that comes from a deep abiding presence of God, and comes from the absence of immorality, sin, and crime. It is the kingdom that God wants us to build, with His direction, here on earth.

It's a wonderful and hopeful image, and that is a wonderful way to begin Advent. We are preparing to celebrate the coming God into our world as a human being, the birth of Jesus Christ, God Incarnate. Yes, we are

preparing for Christmas day. God's gift of Himself to us.

Our first reading describes what should have happened when Jesus entered our world. It describes what God desires for us. God desires a deep and lasting peace for us that will only happen if we live the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ.

However, the reality is what we heard in our second reading. The people have not streamed to Jesus and His teachings, so those who have come to believe that Jesus is God Incarnate find themselves outnumbered by those who have maintained their pagan and immoral lives.

We heard St. Paul instruct the Christians in Rome that they are to "put on Christ" in order to conduct themselves properly, and to walk in the ways of God. That is how they will build the Kingdom of God in the midst of the very immoral pagan culture in Rome.

Paul listed immoral actions that he wants the Christians to avoid. He is telling them that they cannot do the same things that they see the pagan Romans doing. He is exhorting the Christians to be countercultural, and for them to be countercultural is to be holy, virtuous, loving, kind, and merciful.

Our culture is becoming more like the pagan culture of the first centuries of Christianity. We, the Christians of this century, like the early Christians 2,000 years ago, must be countercultural by "putting on Christ" and walking in the ways of God. As you have heard me preach quite a bit recently, the Kingdom of God has very high standards.

Our culture is doing the opposite of our first reading. It is streaming away from God to be instructed in the ways of immorality and sin in order to walk the paths of lust, pornography, violence, greed, promiscuity, and drunkenness. Proof of that can be found by watching almost any PG-13 or R rated movie coming out of Hollywood, or watching an hour of any of the top-rated television programs along with the commercials. Our culture is not much different from the pagan Romans of the first century. Like them, we are entertained by lust, pornography, violence, greed, promiscuity, and drunkenness. When we are entertained by that, we are putting on sin, instead of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The violence and immorality that we see in our world should convince us that we need to be countercultural, rather than being more like our culture. It is not logical to make the observation that the world is full of violence and immorality, and at the same time want the Catholic Church to be less strict with its moral teachings. How is that going to make the world a better place? How is that going to build the Kingdom of God? Knowing that our world is growing more violent and more immoral should lead everyone to the logical conclusion that the Catholic Church must stand firm on all its moral teachings.

In the season of Advent, we prepare to celebrate the first coming of Jesus when He was born in Bethlehem. However, the gospel passage for the First Sunday of Advent always points us to His second coming. The best way to prepare for the second coming of Jesus is the same way we should prepare to celebrate His first coming on Christmas. We strive to live a life of faith, holiness, virtue, love, and mercy, and reject the immoral norms of our culture. We repent of our sins, and go to Confession frequently.

The gospel passage raises two questions in my mind. First, are we prepared to meet Jesus? Our Lord was very clear that His second coming will be very sudden, and not everyone will be saved. That means that He could come back tomorrow. So, if Jesus were to come back tomorrow, are we ready to meet Him? If not, then use this Advent to begin the process of making the changes necessary to live a life more in communion with Him. Begin to live His teachings and the teachings of the Catholic Church with more fervor.

Which brings me to a suggestion for all of us. Read the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John during the Advent season. When you read the gospels this Advent season, do it with the mindset that you want to allow yourself to be instructed by the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ so that you may walk in His ways.

Here's the second question: Do we need to be saved? Do we really want Jesus to be our Savior? Answering "Yes" to that means that we are admitting that we are really in danger. What is the danger? Sin and immorality. Jesus saved us from our sins, which means we are in danger of going to hell if we do not live the teachings of Jesus, do not repent of our sins, and do not strive to live a life of holiness, love, mercy, forgiveness,

I'm not sure if you have ever heard it said like that. Since Jesus is our Savior, then we must really and truly be in danger, and that danger is an eternity in hell if we do not live the teachings of Jesus, do not repent of our sins, do not strive to live a life of faith, holiness, virtue, love, and morality, and refuse to reject the immoral norms of our culture.

It is because we are in danger that Jesus came down from heaven in order to teach us how we are to live, and because we do not always live the way he taught, He suffered and died for us. However, His suffering and death will not help us if we do not go to Him. We need Him to save us and rescue us from our sins. When we go to Him to be rescued, He can change our life. The first reading told us what would happen if all of humanity would follow His teachings and allow Him to save us from our sins. Good things can happen when Jesus is in our life, and bad things will happen when we reject Him.

Our first reading is more than a beautiful scripture passage. It is true. When we allow Jesus to instruct us, we will throw off the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light. When we truly "put on Christ," we will encounter a peace more profound than the absence of war. It will be the peace that comes from the deep abiding presence of our Savior, our Lord Jesus Christ, dwelling within us.

That is the kind of peace that we all desire. It is the result of acknowledging that without Jesus, our eternal soul is in danger, but when we allow Jesus to truly be our Savior, we can rest in the peace of His infinite love and mercy. Let's use this Advent to prepare ourselves to meet our Lord, and by doing that, we will also be preparing ourselves to celebrate the birth of our Savior, our Lord Jesus Christ on Christmas.
