Holy Family – YRA 2025

I love all the readings today, so let's begin with the first reading. This passage naturally assumes each family has a father and a mother. That was normal until about 60 years ago. The breakdown of the traditional family structure has led to a breakdown in our culture. Avoid anyone who encourages or promotes anything other than a family with one dad and one mom. Children thrive in a home with a mom and a dad who love each other and love their children. One of the consequences of the sexual revolution are families without a dad. Being a single mom is hard, so those families frequently have more problems than a home with a mom and a dad. Abstaining from sex until marriage contributes to strengthening our culture, while engaging in sex before marriage adds to the dysfunction and brokenness of our culture.

Sadly, marriage and family life are not perceived as desirable by many in our culture. Marriage rates are dropping, and too often, children are perceived as a burden and distraction from a career or hobbies. That is not a healthy perspective for any culture. Most good parents will say that having children changed them for the better. Children are a lot of work, but some of the many blessings of children is that they helped their mom and dad to discover a greater capacity to love than they thought possible, helped them mature as they became parents for the first time, and helped them become better Christians as they turn to God more frequently in prayer as they begin the awesome responsibility of being parents.

In a healthy home, the dad shows affection for his wife, and is respectful to her at all times. By doing that, the dad is demonstrating to the children that they are to always respect and honor their mother. The dad will enforce that with appropriate actions. The dad leads the family in prayer, along with his wife. The children need to learn from dad that prayer is important. When the children see both parents praying, that demonstrates the importance of prayer to the children.

When the dad is disrespectful to his wife, or when the mom is disrespectful to her husband, dysfunction and division reigns in that home. The children will follow that example and will in turn be disrespectful to their parents, and probably to others in authority because they will see that as normal behavior. It will be difficult to teach children to be respectful to their parents or others if their mom and dad are not respectful to each other. The parents need to be aware that the way they live and the way they speak is teaching the children how to live and speak.

Parents need to discipline their children appropriately so that the children learn how to behave in a respectful Christian manner. The public schools do not teach that. The parents teach that by words and actions. If there are no consequences for inappropriate behavior, the inappropriate behavior will continue. Parents can have difficulty disciplining their children when they are too focused on being their child's friend rather than their parent. I understand it can be difficult to discipline your children because you love them so much, but you must be thinking long-term. Discipling a child is difficult in the present moment, but that consistent appropriate discipline will result in that child becoming a respectful and mature Christian adult. That is the long-term goal.

Unfortunately, I encounter senior citizens who struggle financially, and have no help from their children. Often it is because they are not speaking to each other. There are many reasons for why parents and children do not speak to each other, so it is another illustration of the breakdown in our families and our culture. We know it is not supposed to be that way, but as a result of sin, it is.

How is it supposed to be? We heard in our second reading the qualities we Christians are supposed to strive for, with the help and grace of God (Colossians 3:12b-16): "Heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, bearing with one another, and forgiving one another; as the Lord has forgiven you, so must you also do. And over all these put on love, that is, the bond of perfection. And let the peace of Christ control your hearts...and be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly."

That is possible when we strive to live that way everyday with the help and grace of God. In fact, our responsorial psalm reminded us that "Blessed are those who fear the Lord and walk in his ways." When every member of a family is striving to live as Jesus taught, then that family has the opportunity to become a holy family. A family that strives to love each other, strives to always apologize when they do something wrong, and strives to forgive when the wrong was committed against them is giving themselves the opportunity to be a well-functioning family. This becomes very difficult when some members of the family do not want to live this way. However, we must strive to live that way regardless of how other family members are behaving. Striving to live this way brings some form of normalcy, love, mercy, and compassion into the family and the home. Striving to live this way brings Christ into the family and the home, and that is what each family needs.

We cannot live the way St. Paul has described without being obedient to God and open to His guidance. In our Gospel passage, we see St. Joseph giving us a good example of that. The poor guy had to resign himself to the fact that if anyone in his family was going to commit a sin, it was going to be him. His adopted son is God Incarnate, and his wife, the Blessed Virgin Mary, is without sin because of a special grace from God.

St. Joseph, like Joseph in the Book of Genesis, experiences communication from God through his dreams. He is open to hear the voice of God, and he responds promptly with obedience. Here are a few things that usually help us to be open to hear the voice of God in our lives. First, devote adequate time every day to prayer, including silence so that we can sense God changing our heart and perhaps even placing helpful thoughts in our head. Second, when reading the Bible, we should take time to sit in silence and meditate on what we have read, to give the word of God a chance to dwell in us richly. Third, make an appointment to speak with me if you are in need of help in discerning correctly what God wants you to do. Fourth, practice a little bit of penance every Friday by giving up some pleasures in life since they can easily become more important than our relationship with God.

Because our fallen human nature is attracted to immoral pleasure, and since we do not always trust God, that causes us to sometimes do our will rather than God's will. That is disobedience. True, life is not easy when we strive to live in obedience to God, but it is better. Life without God almost always involves more sin, and that creates more problems and dysfunction in families. Obeying God is the great example of St. Joseph, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and all the saints. We need to imitate that. In fact, that is the only way we are going to be allowed to enter heaven.

One of the most important things that families need to do is to pray together. When they sit down to eat, they need to pray before meals. That traditional Catholic prayer before meals is in the bulletin this weekend. Mom and dad should pray with their children as they are going to bed. As the children get older, they can say their prayers on their own, but moms and dads might need to remind them. Pray in your vehicle each time your family takes a trip. As we were pulling out of the driveway for a family trip, my mom would lead us in an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be for safe travel. One more thing, if your family is not praying a rosary together, then try praying the rosary together one day a week. Make that a New Year's resolution, or maybe begin that during Lent, but then keep doing it after Lent is over.

There is no perfect family. Every family has difficulties and problems. Even the Holy Family had trials and tribulations. The key is to have realistic expectations, and to be less concerned about our needs, and more concerned about the needs of others. When every family member does that, prays together, and goes to Mass together, then families, even though they are not perfect, can become good and holy families. With the help and grace of God, each family in this parish can be a good and holy family. On the Feast of the Holy Family, may God bless all our families, and may every family member strive to be a good and holy person.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no tourism at all. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United States to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income will be able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.




