## 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent – YRA 2026

The Transfiguration of Jesus takes place in Chapter 17 of the Gospel of Matthew, and four chapters later He enters Jerusalem on what we call Palm Sunday. Thus, when He is transfigured, the time of His Passion is not very far away.

Peter, James, and John witnessed this marvelous event. They had seen Jesus do many marvelous and miraculous things. He calmed a stormy sea, walked on water, and multiplied the fish and the loaves. They also had seen Him cure lepers, the blind, the mute, and many, many who had all kinds of diseases and illnesses. However, He did all this while looking like you and me. When He was transfigured, Peter, James, and John were given a glimpse of Jesus' divinity. They saw Him in all His glory. The appearance of Jesus changed such that (Mt 17:2) "...his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light." The Transfiguration verifies that Jesus is God.

Three times our Lord predicted that He would suffer and die (Matt 16:21; 17:22-23; 20:17-19). The Transfiguration is immediately preceded and followed by the first two. Suffering and dying does not seem like something God would do. However, God is love, and His suffering and death to save us from our sins are an act of love. God cannot suffer and die for us unless He has a human body. That is why the Son of God, Jesus, was born of the Blessed Virgin Mary. During the Transfiguration, divine light pours forth from Jesus. However, when He is crucified, blood will pour forth. Jesus is human and divine.

God needed a human body to suffer and die for our sins, which would establish a New Covenant, and open the doors to heaven so that we could spend all eternity with Him in the glory of heaven. We enter into God's glory upon our death by doing our best here on Earth to live all that God teaches, and by always striving to do His will. That is the narrow road to heaven, and in heaven is where we too will see Jesus in all His glory.

As we know, living what God teaches and always striving to do His will is much easier said than done. While our Lord's death on the cross clearly revealed God's love for us, it also revealed that sin is a horrible thing. We need to remove it from our life because sin does not belong in heaven, nor in His kingdom here on Earth.

In our gospel passage two weeks ago, we heard Jesus raise the moral standards. He wants us to live by those high moral standards because that is what is expected of us in heaven. That is what is expected of us to be in communion with God. In our gospel passage last weekend, we heard about the temptation of Jesus in the desert. We too face temptation. However, while Jesus did not give in to the temptation, we frequently do.

We can fall into despair when we realize that we often fall short of the high moral standards that Jesus has given us, and we often give in to temptation. Is God going to give up on us? No! God will never give up on us. He knows the temptations we face that cause us to fall into sin. That is why He died for us on the cross, and that is why He always offers us mercy when we repent. Pope Francis said that we tire of asking for God's mercy, but God never tires of offering mercy to us. God is for us, not against us (Rom 8:31). He wants us in heaven with Him. He wants us to repent each time we fall into sin.

Let me remind you once again of the Collect (Opening Prayer) for the 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary time: "O God, who manifest your almighty power above all by pardoning and showing mercy." Jesus manifested His divine glory during the Transfiguration, and during the Crucifixion.

God manifests His almighty power by granting us mercy when we repent of our sins. We see examples of that mercy in the Gospels. Next week, we are going to hear about the Samaritan woman at the well (John 4:4-26). Jesus knew she was coming, and wanted a personal one-on-one encounter with her. The women of the town wanted nothing to do with her, but Jesus was not like them. He knew her past, and her sins, but He did not berate her nor yell at her. He gave her an experience of God's love and mercy, and encouraged her to change her life.

The woman caught in adultery (John 8:1-11) also received an experience of God's love and mercy, and she too was encouraged to change her life. Jesus did not come all the way down from heaven to die for our sins just to tell us "I love you." He loves us, and He wants us to repent of our sins. God knows what we can be. We can become saints with God's grace, and the desire to live a virtuous and moral life.

In chapter seven of the Gospel of Luke (7:36-50), a sinful woman washed the feet of Jesus with her tears, and then dried them with her hair. Obviously, Jesus is very approachable, even when we have lived a life that everyone knows is sinful. The woman was publicly known to be a sinner, which means she probably was a prostitute. Yet, He does not berate her nor scold her. Her tears reveal that she has repented of her sins. Jesus was revealing that God is so much more merciful than we can imagine. His teachings encourage us to live the life of a saint, and His mercy is always there for us when we fall short. Never give up trying to become a saint because God will never give up on us, and He will always offer us His mercy when we ask for it.

The people thought the blind man, Bartimaeus, was a nuisance to Jesus (Mark 10:46-52). However, Jesus is not bothered or annoyed by Bartimaeus. Jesus makes time for him. We are never a nuisance to Jesus. We don't annoy Him. Why? Because He sees us as a gift to Himself.

Jesus actually said that in the Gospel of John (17:24): “Father, they are your gift to me.” He said that the night before He was crucified. Think about that. He knew that the next day He was going to be scourged and crucified, yet He said that we are a gift to Him from the Father. Us, the people He had to suffer severely for, the people He had to die for, He said we are a gift to Him. Each of us, each time we look in a mirror will see a person that Jesus sees as a gift to Him. Is that how we see ourselves? Are we seeing ourselves the way Jesus sees us? The truth and the reality are that we are a gift to Jesus. The lie is that God cannot love us. That lie comes from the evil one. The truth is that Jesus said we are a gift to Him. The truth sets us free to become the saint that God knows we can be.

When we believe the reality and the truth that Jesus sees us as a gift to Him from the Father, then it is much easier to enter into a relationship with Him. Yes, us, with all our brokenness and all our woundedness are invited into a deep relationship with Jesus Christ. It’s something He wants with each of us because He sees each of us as a gift to Himself from the Father. It is this deep relationship that the evil one is constantly trying to prevent from happening. Hence, the lies that we hear in our head that we are worthless, good for nothing, and there is no way that God can love a person like you and me are from the evil one. Who are we going to believe? Who are we going to listen to, the evil one or Jesus? Listen to Jesus, follow Him, and obey Him.

We please God when we listen to Him. We please God when we repent of our sins. Jesus began His public ministry by preaching (Matt 4:17) “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.” Thus, when we repent of our sins, God is pleased that we are listening to Him, and heeding of His call for us to repent, and since He wants us to repent, that must mean He will grant us all the mercy we need when we repent. This is great news! We receive all the mercy we need from God when we sincerely ask for it. In one of His appearances to St. Faustina, Jesus told her, “The greater the sinner, the greater their right to my mercy.”

Lent is about repentance. About transforming into the virtuous, loving, merciful, and courageous person that God wants us to be. The Good News is that God always offers us all the mercy we need when we repent. If we keep repenting every single time we sin, and we will be doing that countless times, and we keep striving to live according to God’s will, then we will die in friendship with God, and we will have the opportunity to gaze upon the glory of God in heaven for all eternity.
