## Easter Sunday – YRA 2026

Jesus died on the cross, but He rose from the dead three days later. It is the reason we are gathered here today, and it is the reason we are Christians. If Jesus stayed dead, there would be no Christians.

Many great historical figures have led exemplary lives, taught wise doctrines, and even died for a good cause, but only about Jesus Christ can we say: "He rose again on the third day, in fulfillment of the scriptures." By dying for our sins and rising from the dead, Jesus conquered sin, Satan, and death! In His resurrection, love and power are clearly manifested together. God has demonstrated that love and power are not supposed to be opposed to each other, but united toward the same purpose.

In God, love, mercy, and power are the same because God is love. God's almighty power is manifested in His love and mercy. In Christ's resurrection, love proves that it is stronger than death. In a certain sense, we can say that Jesus "broke" death. Death has no power over Him. Death could not contain Him. If we follow Him and obey Him, death will have no power over us. Thus, for those who follow and obey Jesus, death has become the gateway to eternal life in heaven.

Because Jesus rose from the dead, a wildly new hope dawned for all humanity, the hope that if we stay united to Him through faith and grace, we will rise with Him and live with Him forever in heaven. No one else offers such a hope, because no one else but Jesus Christ has died for our sins and risen from the dead.

The Resurrection is the definitive moment in the history of religions; it makes Christianity absolutely unique. Only the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead can explain the reality of the history of the Church: A few weak, non-influential, and uneducated fishermen from Galilee, who fled in fear when Jesus was arrested, suddenly become world travelers, phenomenally successful preachers, and valiant martyrs. And the Church they helped to begin continued to spread after they died, holding fast to the exact same doctrine they preached, century after century, in nation after nation. Only the abiding and living presence of Jesus can explain this, and only the resurrection explains the abiding presence of the Lord.

Because we Christians believe in the resurrection, we are going to look at the world differently than most people. Human beings are a body and a soul. Our body will die, but our soul will never die. Our soul will live for all eternity, and an eternity is much longer than a trillion years (the Big Bang was 13.5 billion years ago). So, what's more important, the teachings that come from God, or the norms that come from our culture? Will our culture last forever? No. Has any culture on this planet lasted forever? No. So, once again, what's more important? The norms of a culture that is going to cease to exist at some point in the future, or the teachings of God that tell us how to live in His kingdom now, and for all eternity?

Most people live according to the norms of this culture, and they are not content with their life. There is an emptiness in them that won't go away. No matter how many pleasurable things they engage in, that empty feeling is still there. C.S Lewis wrote that, "If we find ourselves with a desire that nothing in this world can satisfy, the most probable explanation is that we were made for another world."

Our citizenship is in heaven. That means that heavenly things are far more important than earthly things. Earthly things can never completely satisfy us, only things of heaven. A person who understands that this world can never satisfy their deepest desires, will look to have those deepest desires met by the only thing that can, God. That means we need to nurture our relationship with Jesus Christ, and learn to love Him and obey Him. That necessarily means we need to read the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, and the teachings of the Holy Catholic Church to know how to live as a citizen of heaven.

Our culture is going to cease to exist at some point in the future, and our bodies are going to die. That's the bad news. However, the good news is that Jesus died for our sins, rose from the dead, and offers us eternal life. The Resurrection is our hope. Jesus Christ, in His death and resurrection, has made all things new.

We are made for more than this planet. We are made for heaven. Jesus has shown us that there is life after death, and He is inviting us to spend an eternity with Him in heaven. He wants us to live for heaven, which means we need to die to the things of this world.

During Lent we give up things to help us to die to things of this world, and to die to sin, so that throughout the year we can do a better job saying "no" to sin, to Satan, and to the things in our culture that are not of God. At this point in every Easter Mass, we renew our baptismal vows. Once again, we will proclaim that we want to die to sin and Satan, so that we might rise with Jesus, confident in His love and mercy. Please stand, and let's renew our baptismal vows.

Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy."

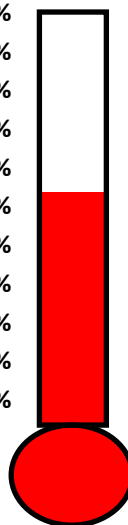

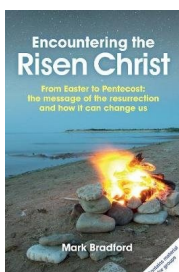
