17th Sunday in Ordinary Time – YRA 2026

Imagine God appearing to you in a dream like He did to Solomon in the first reading, and saying to you: “Ask something of me and I will give it to you.” How are you going to respond? What is your heart’s desire? What do you treasure above all? Is it to meet a favorite celebrity or athlete? Is it to be a celebrity or athlete? Is it good health? Is it a dream home or a dream vacation? Is it job security or financial security? What is your heart’s desire? What do you treasure above all?

Solomon’s desire was to be a good king. He wanted to serve the people well, but since he was a young man, he did not have the wisdom that comes with age and life experience, so he asked for wisdom. He asked for an understanding heart in order to judge right from wrong.

From time-to-time I encounter older senior citizens who are wondering why they have not died. They have had a long life, and their heart’s desire cannot be satisfied by anything on this planet. They want very much to be with God in heaven.

We should treasure God and heaven above all things. That is what Jesus is telling us in the first two parables that we heard in today’s Gospel. They are very big hints to how we should answer the question, “If God could give you anything, what would you ask for?” We should treasure the Kingdom of Heaven above all things because the alternative is not pleasant.

The third parable in today’s Gospel passage was about judgment. The alternative to the Kingdom of Heaven is horrible. There is not a third option. Jesus uses the description of a “fiery furnace, where there will be wailing, and grinding of teeth” (Matthew 13:50).

Let me repeat something I said five weeks ago. Jesus is warning us about the danger of hell. It is real, and it must truly be a terrible place if it is the one thing Jesus said that we should fear (Matt 10:28). We do not automatically go to heaven. Jesus was clear about that today, in several other teachings (Matt 7:13-14, 21-23; 10:28; Luke 13:23-30), and in six different parables about judgement (Matt 13:24-30; 13:47-50; 22:1-14; 25:1-13; 25:14-30; 25:31-46). If we purposely live without God in this life without repenting before we die, then He will allow us to live without Him for all eternity in hell.

A question for all of us. Do we desire heaven because we fear the whole fiery furnace thing where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth, or do we desire heaven because we truly love God? In other words, do we reluctantly follow Jesus out of fear of hell, or do we follow Jesus because we love Him and His commands? Did singing the responsorial psalm taste like vinegar in our mouth, or was it sweet to sing?

You see, if we do not love God’s commands, and we do not love the teachings of Jesus, we will be miserable Christians. God knows our hearts, so if we have no desire to live according to His holy and divine will for all eternity, then He will allow us to spend our eternity in hell. Everyone in heaven loves God’s commands and knows His holy and divine will is the best way to live.

When we are doing our best to live according to the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Holy Catholic Church, we will be good productive soil, and the Fruits of the Spirit will be abundant in our life. As a reminder, they are (Galatians 5:22): love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. That is not misery. That is heavenly. When we treasure God’s commands and the teachings of Jesus, and live them, the result is an abundance of the Fruits of the Spirit in our life.

In the first chapter of the Gospel of John, two disciples of John the Baptist leave him to follow Jesus at four o’clock in the afternoon the day after Jesus was baptized (John 1:35-39). Why does that passage mention the exact time it happened. Why that detail? John remembers that detail because his life changed at four o’clock that day. He found the pearl of great price. He found a treasure. He encountered Jesus Christ for the first time. When we truly encounter Jesus Christ, our life will change. Jesus, and His kingdom, is the pearl of great price, it is a treasure. Nothing else in this world has value when compared to Jesus Christ.

When St. Paul encountered Jesus Christ on the road to Damascus, he could not go back to his previous life. He discovered the pearl of great price; he discovered a treasure. St. Francis gave up the wealth of his family because none of that mattered compared to the treasure he discovered in the Kingdom of Heaven. St. Thomas Aquinas stopped writing about God when he had a vision of God. He said everything he had written about God was just chaff compared to what God is really like. Nothing in this world has value when compared to Jesus Christ and the Kingdom of Heaven because nothing is more precious than our eternal salvation, and the infinite love and mercy of God.

How we spend our time and our money reveals where our heart is, for where our heart is, there our treasure will be (Matt 6:21). Remember also the rich young man who could not leave his riches behind to follow Jesus (Matt 19:16-22). He was too attached to his wealth and possessions, so he could not sell them in order to follow Jesus. He missed out on an opportunity that literally came only once in all of human history. Standing in front of him was a treasure far beyond any of his possessions, but he could not see that because he treasured his wealth and possessions too much.

It is easier to fall into that trap than we realize. How often have we missed Mass because of football, soccer, or some other event that was going on? Is football, soccer, or any other event really more important than truly encountering our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist? Are they our treasure? Without thinking about it, do our actions say that Jesus Christ and His kingdom are just chaff compared to football, soccer, or some other event?

When we truly encounter our Lord Jesus Christ, nothing on this planet can compare to the riches of His love and mercy, and the treasure of the Kingdom of Heaven. That encounter can happen when we know in the depths of our being that even though we are sinners, Jesus loves us personally, and He died for each of us. God knows the worst things we have done, but He died to save us from our sins, and He still is willing to forgive us each time we repent and ask for His love and mercy. When we know that in the depths of our being, we have found the pearl of great price; we have discovered a treasure that surpasses all riches on this planet.

St. Paul wrote about that in his Letter to the Philippians (3:7-9a): “But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as refuse, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him.”

The evil one knows that the Kingdom of Heaven is a great treasure for us. Thus, he will continue to tempt us to put other things before God and His kingdom. He wants us to think that heaven will be hell, and hell will be like heaven. He is a liar, and his lies are seductive because after thousands of years of experience he knows how to tempt our fallen human nature. He knows the best way to distract us from God and His kingdom is to convince us that pursuing earthly pleasure is a better use of our time than pursuing the Kingdom of God.

The result is that those who are pursuing earthly pleasure like drugs, alcohol, pornography, computer games, gambling, social media, money, etc., etc., often find themselves addicted and slaves to the pleasure they put before God and His kingdom. When that happens, they are experiencing a little bit of hell on earth because what they have valued and treasured above all has left them empty of meaning and purpose. They may even feel like life is no longer worth living because what they pursued and valued above all: good looks, pleasure, drugs, alcohol, and sex has drained them of life itself. Sometimes we will say that, "They have hit bottom."

We are a body and a soul. Our body is made for this planet, but our soul is made for heaven. If we live as if this planet is all there is, then our soul is not being nourished. That is the big empty feeling people have when they make pleasure their treasure.

God allows some people to hit bottom because that is the only way to get them to change. When they hit bottom, we need to be willing to help them without enabling them, and we need to be willing to talk with them about the love of God.

I preach frequently about letting our actions do the preaching. However, there comes a time when the most loving thing we can do is to tell someone about Jesus. Will the person we are speaking with know that we believe what we are saying? Will they know that we are speaking about something that we treasure and value above all things? Someone's soul may depend on it. By the way, there is a book from Catholic Answers in our gift shop titled *How to Talk About Jesus with Anyone*.

In the end, treasuring the Kingdom of God is not just about our immortal soul. It is about getting everyone to heaven. That's what God wants. Some people have lost their way, but God has not given up on them. Remember, He does not judge us until the end of our life. Our love for God could be what brings someone back to Him before it is too late.

Jesus came to save the lost. As Christians, our goal is to be like Jesus. Thus, saving the lost is the work of all those who have the name Christian. May we treasure the Kingdom of God above all things, and with the grace of God, may we help those who are lost to find the pearl of great price, to find the treasure that is Jesus Christ and the Kingdom of God.

Religious Education for Children and Adults

Registration for Religious Education will take place after all the Masses on Sunday, August 2 and Sunday, August 9 in the parish hall. These classes are for children (7- 17 years old) who need Baptism, First Confession, First Holy Communion, or Confirmation, or for adults who need any of these Sacraments already listed. For those who cannot register on Sunday, Deacon John will also be available in Rm 102 on Wednesday, August 5 and 12. All registration will take place only on these dates, and then will be closed for this year. A \$5 fee will be charged for each person registered to cover the cost of supplies. In order to register, you will need to be a registered parishioner at St. Margaret Mary and provide the following documentation:

For children (7 years old and up) and adults who need Baptism-

Birth Certificate,

Proof of sponsor's good standing

For children (7 years old and up) and adults who need 1st Confession-

Birth Certificate and Baptism Certificate

For children (8 years old and up) and adults who need 1st Communion/Confirmation-

Baptism Certificate.

In the past, we have had considerable difficulty getting all the documents in a timely manner. In order to avoid this, it is recommended that parents should pick up a registration packet either in the Parish Office, the Ghipht Shop, or from Rm 102 prior to the dates for registration to help them secure the necessary documents in time. Registration cannot be completed without all documents and no child will attend classes without being registered.

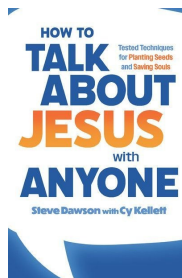
