14th Sunday in Ordinary Time – YRA 2026

In the movie *Where the Red Fern Grows*, based upon the book of the same name, the main character is a 12-year-old boy named Billy. All he can think about is having his own pair of hunting dogs. He complains to his grandfather that he has been praying a long time for hunting dogs, but God has not answered his prayers. His grandfather wisely told him, “God will do his part, but you have to do your part.” Billy was not quite sure what that meant, but after a little while he realized that if he was willing to work hard to earn the money to buy the dogs, God will give him the strength to do the work. That illustrates one of the truths of our faith: Jesus Christ does not do things for us; He does things with us. One more time, Jesus Christ doesn’t do things for us, he does things with us.

The saints prayed hard and worked hard. That certainly describes the lives of St. John Paul II and St. Theresa of Calcutta. In fact, St. Augustine said, “Pray as though everything depended on God. Work as though everything depended on you.” It is the prayer that yokes the saints to Jesus Christ. It is the prayer that invites God into their life and their work so that all that they do, they do with God. The saints want to work with God, not against Him, so their prayer also helps them to discern God’s will, so that they build His kingdom. We cannot build the Kingdom of God without God, so it means we pray hard and work hard. We yoke ourselves to Jesus Christ who promises to help us carry the burden of building His kingdom.

The last part of the gospel passage we heard today assumes that life will be burdensome at times, and Jesus said nothing about getting rid of life’s burdens. However, He said if we humbly go to Him for help, He will walk with us and help us carry our burdens. Nowhere in the gospels does Jesus say that being a Christian will be easy, and at no time did He say that if we believe in Him, we will avoid pain, suffering, and difficulties. He is clear, He does not want us to bear the burden of our difficulties alone, and He does not want us to walk through this life alone.

In February 2016, my dad died of Lou Gehrig’s Disease, also known as ALS. He went to church every Sunday, he volunteered once a week with Meals on Wheels, and volunteered once or twice a week with an agency that arranged rides to medical appointments for those who didn’t have a car. Once a week he delivered meals, and once or twice a week he drove someone to their appointment. Why would God allow a person like that to contract Lou Gehrig’s Disease? I do not have an answer to that question, but I do know that Jesus invites us to come to Him when life gets hard. My dad kept going to church, he kept praying, and he learned to ask for help. My dad did not face Lou Gehrig’s Disease alone because he allowed God, his family, and medical personnel to help him. Had my dad allowed his pride to get in the way, and not humbly allowed others to help him, he would have walked that journey alone, and probably would have become very miserable, bitter, and angry.

Sometimes our pride gets in the way of God helping us. In the midst of tremendous difficulties, some people believe that they can manage all those difficulties by themselves. Who encourages our pride so that we isolate ourselves in the midst of tremendous difficulties? The evil one. He wants us to suffer alone. That is completely the opposite of what Jesus taught us. That is not how Jesus wants Christians to go through life. Jesus taught us to go to Him when life gets hard.

When Jesus sent the disciples out to preach the Good News, He sent them out in pairs (Luke 10:1) so that none of them would have to bear that burden alone. They would always have someone to “lean on.” In fact, what is the most common way that God helps us? It is through other people. When we isolate ourselves in the midst of great difficulties, it is very difficult for God to help us, since the help we need is usually the kind of help that only other people can provide. Remember, God will do His part, but we need to do our part. That means we must humbly admit that we cannot do everything on our own. We need the help of God and others.

So, God will permit difficulties in our life, no matter how good we have been. When difficulties come our way, that is not punishment from God. That is just a reality of living on this planet. Jesus, being aware of that, told us to come to Him when life is hard.

When a woman finds herself unexpectedly pregnant, she can either walk that journey alone, or she can ask for help. Going to Planned Parenthood is not helpful because they provide no emotional support, and they do not want to accompany the pregnant woman during her pregnancy. What they want is for her to pay them for an abortion. Their only answer is to kill an innocent baby. That is not the kind of help Jesus was talking about in our gospel today.

Jesus wants to walk with us during our difficulties. Where can a woman find someone to walk with her, to accompany her when she is unexpectedly pregnant? Hopefully, family, friends, and a Christian pregnancy center like Advice and Aid Pregnancy Center in Kingman. Christian pregnancy centers are exactly the kind of thing that Jesus has in mind. Meet the person where they are, and then walk with them to greater holiness of life, especially when doing the good and moral thing is hard. Jesus wants us to come to Him, and He wants us to walk with others. He does not want anyone walking alone on the road to heaven. Advice and Aid Pregnancy Center in Kingman walks with women during their pregnancy. They walk with women to greater holiness of life, especially when the road to holiness is not easy.

A complaint is often made that if God is love and all powerful, then He would remove all pain and suffering from this planet. Is it possible that God permits suffering because it makes us better? Is the life of a world class athlete free of pain and suffering? No. In fact, a common phrase for those who exercise to stay fit is: “No pain, no gain.” Athletes deny themselves all kinds of things in order to stay in the best possible shape, and endure workouts that cause physical discomfort in order to attain their full potential.

It is no different for Christians. God wants us to attain our fullest potential. He wants us to be saints. He wants us to always choose what is good, beautiful, and true, no matter how hard it may be. He allows temptation so that we can strengthen our ability to say “no” to it. When we say “yes” to temptation, that lets us know where we are weak so that we can work on growing in virtue in that area of our life.

In addition, God allows difficulties in our life in order to develop a greater capacity for moral courage. With all the immorality in the world, we need moral courage in order to live our Christian faith and morals with love and humility. It is too easy to pretend we are not a Christian in order to fit in at work, school, or our neighborhood. God wants us to practice overcoming difficulties in life, with His help, so that we will live our Christian faith and morals all the time, especially at those times when it would be easier to pretend that we are not a Christian.

We are inspired by those who have overcome great difficulties in life. God permits difficulties in our life to give us an opportunity to do great things. In a scene in a movie about a women's baseball league during World War II, the catcher is not getting on the team bus, so the manager walks over to her, and says, "So, you're leaving?" The catcher responds, "It got too hard." To which the manager responds, "It's supposed to be hard. It's the hard that makes it great."

Life is hard. Christianity is hard. In fact, Jesus said (Matt 7:13-14): "Enter by the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way easy, that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard, that leads to life." And it is the hard that makes it great. There are no great difficulties to overcome in heaven, so our life on this planet is our only opportunity to be courageous and heroic. Our life on this planet is our only opportunity to do great things for God as we build His kingdom. Pope Benedict XVI said, "The ways of the Lord are not easy, but we were not created for an easy life, but for great things, for goodness."

Jesus said that He is (John 14:6), "The way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." The way to holiness and heaven is not a secret. Jesus knows the way, and it is not easy. He is inviting us to come to Him in order to journey together through all of life's difficulties and obstacles, and as we walk with Him, He is leading us to holiness and heaven. There is nothing greater than that.

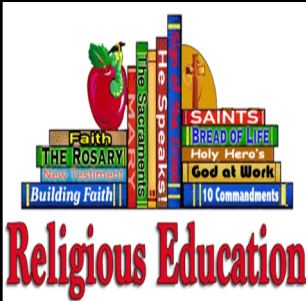

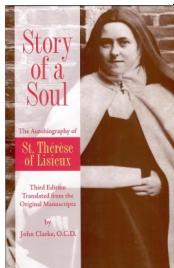


Religious Education for Children
